<b>POLICY STATEMENT</b>	

Monash University offers industry-based experiences that:

- provide direct engagement between students and industry/workplaces
- enhance graduate employability and success through skills development.

The University seeks to ensure that industry-based experiences:

- are quality assured
- meet legal requirements and obligations
- are aligned with University policies and procedures
- are subject to appropriate due diligence and risk assessment processes.

Industry-based experiences may occur at the undergraduate, coursework postgraduate and graduate research (HDR) levels, and may include:

- Curriculum-based Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) activities such as placements, industry projects and field trips
- Co-curricular experiences such as internships, industry projects and mentoring programs.
