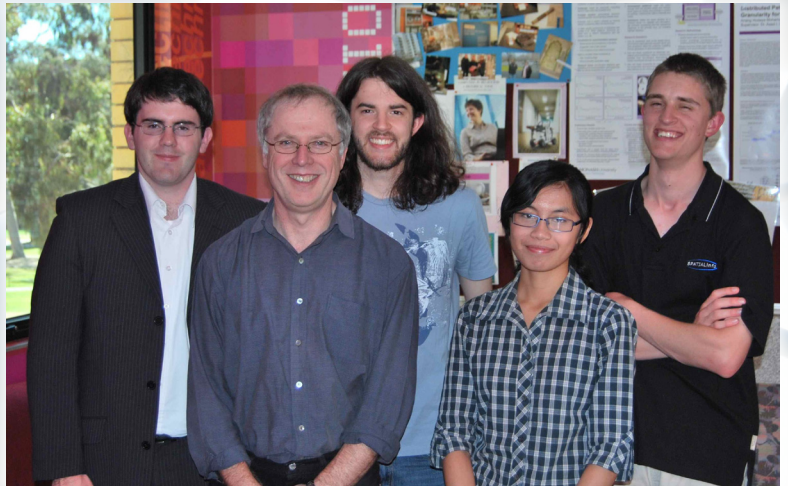

Monash Undergraduate Research Projects Abroad (MURPA) supports a unique summer mode placement in a leading research group overseas. It not only provides a research experience at the undergraduate level, but does this in an international context. Students are placed for a period of eight weeks allowing them to integrate into the research groups as team members.

MURPA also involves an advanced seminar scheme, in which students can attend seminars given by world leading experts before they leave. The seminar scheme is novel, because it uses cutting edge High Definition interactive video links with the University of California, making it feasible to attract some of the world's best researchers 'virtually' to Monash. These seminars also allow students to meet potential UCSD mentors and obtain information for possible projects.
