

MEMO: 21 July 2008

MUFY Resulting Question:

The following is a ruling change for the September 2007 MUFY Student Group who have re-enrolled in July 2008 and

- failed one or two subjects at 40%-49%

September 2007 students who have failed one (1) or two (2) subjects only at 40% - 49% for a traditional MUFY subject attempt may enrol

- in the same semesterised subject units that were failed and study the units concurrently including
- English Part A and B, Accounting Part A and B, Globalisation Part A and B and Advanced Mathematics Part A and B should these subject units be in the group of two subjects which the student failed.

September 2007 students who have failed more than two subjects at 40%-49% are not permitted to enrol under the rules above.

September 2007 students who have gained 39% or less for subjects will follow the same rules as the semesterised students without any exceptions to the semesterised rules.

Should the September MUFY students opt to enrol in different units to the subjects which they failed, then the students will be under the semesterised rules without exceptions being made.

Reason for change:

This will assist the traditional MUFY students who have studied MUFY subjects for 12 months and narrowly failed two subjects to possibly gain entry into Monash next semester. This is a one off exception only and does not set a precedence.
