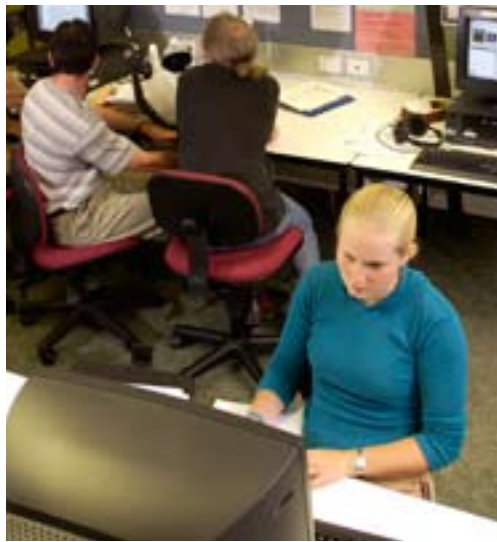
You are invited to see why Monash is regularly ranked as one of the top universities in Australia and Asia, and is ranked 33rd in the world*.

| 11.15 am–12.15 pm | Workshop 1 (Choose one workshop from the following) Physiotherapy: tour the physio labs and be involved in a question and answer session with a current physiotherapy student and an academic. Early childhood and primary school teaching: tour the excellent teaching facilities, participate in some sample classes and find out what it would be like preparing to be a teacher. Business and commerce: listen to current students and hear about the courses in Business available at the Peninsula campus. Accommodation tour: visit the on-campus accommodation facilities |

Occupational therapy: Find out how you can make a difference in a persons every day life by undertaking a Bachelor of Occupational Therapy.
