The qualifications should be in the field of study appropriate to the proposed research interest. Under exceptional circumstances, the Research Graduate School Committee may accept candidates with a degree of a lower grade than honours IIA if they have demonstrated an ability to undertake research at the PhD level, for example by producing evidence of quality work that can be reported on by a referee, or by producing proof of relevant professional experience at a high level.	18
