

Expression of interest for admission to PhD in Health Economics

Overview

Prospective candidates for a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) with the Centre for Health Economics are required to email an expression of interest (EOI) before being invited to apply for admission to a course. Your EOI will be assessed to determine if the course eligibility criteria have been met and suitable supervision and resources are available.

How to submit an expression of interest

To submit an EOI the following is required:

- Title, given name and family name
- Email address
- Evidence that English language requirements have been met
- Copy of all completed university-level academic transcripts, degree certificates and grading scales (official English language translation is required where studies were completed in a language other than English). In addition to the requested documentation a letter indicating what percentage of the degree is research will be required from the relevant institutions.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Research proposal – one page

Email the above information to **buseco-che.hdr.enquiries@monash.edu**

At least four weeks is required for an initial assessment to be performed. All requested documentation must be provided otherwise an initial assessment cannot be performed.

Expressions of interest must be completed at least six weeks before the application closing date for each scholarship round.
