We'll provide intensive catch-ups of missed learning opportunities, especially in practical and clinical experience, after this break period.

We'll also be reviewing assessments so that we can minimise any disruption to your learning.

We know that many international students need to make quick decisions about returning home.

We will support your learning whether or not you are in Australia. If you choose to return home, we recommend that you travel as soon as possible.

Everyone involved in your course is working hard to provide you with the best online learning experience.

Alternatively, you can choose to take a lesser study load while you transit home and spend time with your family.

Some of our students may be asked to join the surge workforce during the COVID-19 crisis

During this time, your skills may be in demand by our health services.

It is your choice to be part of the health service surge workforce.

If you choose to opt-in, as a Monash student, we will continue to support you and ensure you remain fully informed.

Please consider your own circumstances, such as your health and study commitments, before making a decision.
