

Calculators in Assessment Business Process

SCOPE

This business process applies to all undergraduate and postgraduate coursework units offered by Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences (MNHS) as well as units in which the Faculty had majority teaching responsibility.

PURPOSE

To inform Chief Examiners and students of the approved calculators to be used for invigilated assessments.

Approved Calculators

The following calculators have been approved to be used in invigilated assessments (examination and non-examination tasks):

- Casio FX82AU (any version)
- Texas Instruments 30XB

The Faculty of Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences, or any of its Schools or Departments does not issue calculators. Students are responsible for sourcing their own calculators (if they have been approved for use in the assessment)

Instructions for Chief Examiners

Where a chief examiner has permitted the use of a calculator for an invigilated assessment (e.g. In-semester test or end of semester exam) they will note the approved calculators:

- On Moodle
- On the respective coversheet as an approved item

Invigilators will report to unit coordinators and chief examiners the and/or presence of an unauthorised calculator in an assessment, where only an approved calculator is permitted.

The penalty for use/presence of an unauthorised calculator may be in breach of student discipline or academic integrity and will be dealt with in accordance with the [Monash University \(Council\) Regulations](#) and/or [Student Academic Integrity Procedure](#).
