

# Getting started with Graduate Research Supervision at Monash University

## Before you start

## Supervisor categories

There are two categories of supervisor for Monash staff – registered and accredited. Refer to the table below to determine which category is most appropriate for you.

| Registered | Monash staff or adjuncts who are new to supervision of graduate research students | <b>Qualification:</b> AQF level 10 (Doctoral Degree or equivalent)  | <b>Role:</b> Associate only<br><b>Maximum:</b> 3 graduate research students<br><b>Load:</b> 10 - 25% per student  | You will need to complete the online training module:<br><a href="#">Graduate Research Supervision: Registration module</a>  | Once you have completed the Registration module no further action is required.<br><br>Your supervision record will be updated to the category of Registered and will be viewable in your mySupervision record within 5 business days.  |
| Accredited | Monash academic staff or adjuncts with experience supervising PhD students        | <b>Qualification:</b> AQF level 10 (Doctoral Degree or equivalent)<br><b>Supervision experience:</b> minimum 1-year full-time equivalent experience supervising PhD students. Your experience can be through institutions other than Monash University.<br><b>Research Activity:</b> you will need to meet your <a href="#">Faculty Quality Indicators and Research Active Criteria</a> for the Purposes of Graduate Student Supervisor Accreditation | <b>Role:</b> Main or Associate<br><b>Maximum Main:</b> 8 graduate research students<br><b>Maximum Total:</b> 16 graduate research students<br><b>Load:</b> 10 - 90% per student | To apply for <u>new</u> accreditation, you will need to complete two training requirements:<br><i>Part 1 – online module</i><br><a href="#">Graduate Research Supervision: Accreditation online module</a><br><i>Part 2 - workshop</i><br><a href="#">GRS: Introduction to Graduate Research Supervision at Monash</a><br><br>All training should be completed no more than 18 months before submitting your application for accreditation to ensure currency of knowledge | Once you have reviewed the eligibility criteria, completed the required accreditation training and prepared your supporting documentation, refer to our <a href="#">website</a> for how to submit your application.<br><br>Note: Accreditation is not automatically granted upon completion of the training. |

This record contains details of your current and completed students, your role and percentage load per student, student milestone due dates, your registration/accreditation start and expiry dates and a downloadable summary report.
