Occasional address

Darren Creek BPharm(Hons) (2002), PhD (2008)

After completing his PhD at the faculty's Centre for Drug Candidate Optimisation (CDCO) working on the peroxide antimalarial project, Darren spent six months volunteering in Uganda in a district that suffers from very high malaria transmission. There he studied the impact of medications on malaria incidence, treatment and the development of immunity.

Darren faced many frustrations working in a country where poverty, inequality, poor infrastructure and limited education affect so many aspects of life. Thankfully, the team had an opportunity to improve this situation in a small way.

In August, he will travel to Scotland to take up a position as a postdoctoral researcher at the University of Glasgow. The work there will involve using modern metabolomics technology to investigate drugs for the Trypanosoma parasite that causes African sleeping sickness.

Darren was the recipient of the Bachelor of Pharmacy Gold Medal in 2003.
