Requirements for the Bachelor of Education (Honours) Specialisation: D30015 Primary and Secondary Inclusive and Special Education

Total credit points: 204 points

Overload: Students are required to overload by 12 points in year 2 to complete the course in 4 years.

First-year requirement: National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (see [Handbook](#) for details)

Themes

1. Education studies: five units/30 points

2. Curriculum studies: fifteen units/90 points

- Students complete one of the following Primary specialist sequences:

English and literacy

- EDF1084 English and literacies 1
- EDF2049 English and literacies 2
- EDF3079 English and literacies 3
- EDF4009 English and literacies 4
- EDF4047 Leading literacy learning

Mathematics and numeracy

- EDF2066 Mathematics 1
- EDF3067 Mathematics 2
- EDF4078 Leading mathematics learning

- Students complete two [Secondary method units](#) (EDF51XX) in the [discipline area](#) in which they are specialising.

3. Discipline studies: fourteen units/84 points

- Students complete:
 - eight units/48 points, in the inclusive and special education discipline; and
 - six units/36 points, in an elected discipline with at least 12 points each at levels 2 and 3.
- Depending on the discipline area chosen, students may need to complete their discipline units at another Monash campus.

4. Professional experience: six professional experience units/80 days of satisfactory teaching practice.

- Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.

International students please note:

- International students who wish to meet current AITSL skill assessment requirements for secondary teachers must complete EDF3083 Secondary professional experience 3D in place of EDF3082 Secondary professional experience 3A.
- EDF3083 provides the required 10 days of professional experience to meet course requirements, plus an additional 5 days of professional experience in a secondary setting, totalling 15 days of placement.
