

FEE FOR PROVISION OF DATA FROM THE BURNS REGISTRY OF AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND

- The Burns Registry of Australia and New Zealand (BRANZ) is a valuable source of data about burns patients in Australia and New Zealand. Access to the data and requests for data from the BRANZ database is subject to strict access guidelines (Guidelines for Access to Data Collected by the Burns Registry of Australia and New Zealand).
- Requests for data to be provided and/or analysed by BRANZ staff may incur a fee to recoup the administrative costs associated with undertaking this work. Any and all fees associated with the provision of data are subject to approval by, and at the discretion of, the BRANZ Management Team and/or Steering Committee.
- The cost per hour of work (or part thereof) for BRANZ staff is \$100 plus GST (i.e., \$110 AUD). Additional fees may also be charged at the discretion of the BRANZ Management Team and/or Steering Committee.
- If the BRANZ Management Team and/or Steering Committee deem a request for data extraction/analysis warrants a fee, the BRANZ team will provide the requestor with an indicative estimate of the time required and associated costs/fees via email. The requestor must agree to any and all fees in writing before work on the extract/analysis will commence.
- Monash University will provide the requestor with a finalised list of costs and fees (i.e., an invoice) once the extract/analysis is complete. No data or results will be released to the requestor until payment is received.
