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Course requirements

Total credit points: 204 cp (all units are 6 cp unless otherwise specified)

1. ***Overload:** To complete the course in 4 years students are required to overload in year 2 by two units (EDF2088, EDF2099).
 - Students who do not wish to overload in both semesters in year 2 can opt to:
 - a. complete both units during the summer semester at Clayton campus, or
 - b. overload by one unit in year 2 and take one unit in the summer semester at Clayton campus.
 - Students who choose not to overload or study in the summer semester, will extend the duration of their course.
2. **First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students. The Faculty of Education's [LANTITE page](#) has more information on this test.

Core studies	Seven units/42 cp
Education studies	Five units/30 cp ▪ Students complete a 6 cp elective unit. You can select a level 2 or 3 unit from across the university in which you are eligible to enrol. You can also select from a range of flagship rich educational experiences (FREE), including the Monash Innovation Guarantee (MIG), Research, Experimentation and Discovery (RED) or volunteering. These FREE units may be credited in place of your free elective if approved by the faculty. ▪ You must discuss your eligibility with your Education Success Adviser (ESA) prior to enrolling in FREE.
Curriculum studies	Six units/36 cp ▪ Students complete two pairs of Secondary method units in visual art and design: ○ EDF5179 and EDF5180 ○ EDF5181 and EDF5182
Discipline studies	Sixteen units/96 cp ▪ Students complete the requirements of the Bachelor of Fine Art for their discipline studies ▪ You should consult the Faculty of Education course adviser regarding your choice of majors and minors within the partner degree course to ensure you are fulfilling the requirements of the Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT). Refer to the secondary specialist/discipline areas prerequisites and units list. ▪ ^Students must take practical electives from within Fine Art (drawing, film, jewellery, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture), and can also use one of these electives to take the faculty internship unit for an opportunity to apply coursework to real world situations and develop workplace skills.
Professional experience	▪ Six professional experience units/80 days of supervised professional experience in secondary schools. ▪ Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.
