




CALL FOR TUTORS: FIRST YEAR DESIGN STUDIO: SEMESTER 2

Semester 2, 2021



The Foundation Studio 2 aims to introduce beginning students to ways of thinking about and making architecture.

Structure of the studio

ARC1002 (Other Contexts) is a coordinated curriculum with a uniform brief for all tutorial groups. It is carefully structured and all students and tutors follow this structure.

Conceptual framing of the studio

The unit establishes conceptual frameworks for considering site, context, and the development and translation of architectural ideas. The studio engages with contemporary urban situations and residential programs to explore core architectural issues and design practices.

Iterative assignments progress from a series of fortnightly design explorations to a composite design project. The sequence offers students the chance to develop approaches to form and siting, set strategic approaches, explore the development of briefs, consider divisions between public and private domains, and become more aware of the particularities in their own design practice within larger contexts.

Students are encouraged to explore the links between architectural design and wider socio-cultural and environmental developments.

Lead Tutor & Studio Support Teaching Associate

Each studio is led by a Teaching Associate as Lead Tutor with the support of a Studio Support Teaching Associate. Lead Tutors will have experience in the delivery of design studios and working with beginning designers. They will lead studio sessions on Mondays and Thursdays across 12 teaching weeks.

Studio Support Teaching Associates will be recent graduates or new to the studio teaching environment and will support the Lead Tutor sessions each Thursday across 12 teaching weeks.
