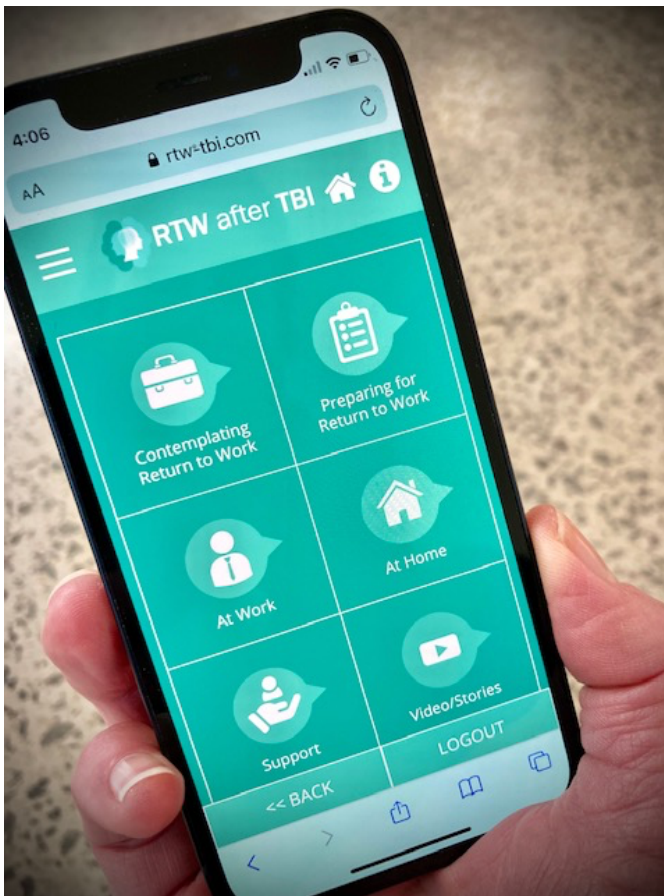


Calling all vocational and return to work providers!

Are you interested in using a new brain injury specialised return to work phone app with your clients?



Dr Lauren Libeson, Dr Pamela Ross, Dr Marina Downing and Professor Jennie Ponsford, expert clinicians and researchers in brain injury and vocational rehab, have developed a return to work after traumatic brain injury (TBI) phone app: **The RTW after TBI app**

This brand-new app contains practical information to help plan for returning to work. It includes some of the difficulties encountered when returning to employment after TBI and strategies to manage these challenges. It also contains videos of individuals with brain injury who share their experiences of return to work.

It has been designed to provide useful information and emotional support to assist you and your client during their return to work journey.

To determine whether the app can improve return to work experiences for individuals with brain injury, we are conducting a **clinical trial**.

We are looking for vocational and return to work providers to take part in this trial by a) providing us with your feedback on the app and b) assisting us to recruit your clients to take part.

You will then be asked to invite your clients with TBI to use the app to assist their return to work, and participate in the trial. You and your clients will be asked to complete some short surveys upon commencing the study and again at 6 months. You will also be asked to participate in an interview to provide your views on the strengths and weaknesses of the app.
