Structured workshop abstract (Max 150 words)	<p>Medication order verification within an Electronic Health Record (EHR) is a complex task requiring evaluation of multiple sources of data to make therapeutic decisions. MyDispense, a well-established free educational tool, has developed an innovative capability to simulate the EHR medication order verification process.</p> <p>Attendees will have the opportunity to interact with the MyDispense EHR system and to collaboratively develop exercises and scenarios that can be shared and incorporated into their own curriculum.</p> <p>Introduction to MyDispense EHR (10 mins) – The workshop will commence with an introduction from the speakers about the features of the MyDispense Electronic Health Record (EHR) simulation platform.</p> <p>Experience MyDispense EHR as a student (20 mins) – participants will be provided a patient case scenario in MyDispense EHR and will be asked to verify medication orders as a “student”.</p> <p>Develop MyDispense Verification Orders (20 mins) – participants will interact with the platform as an “instructor” to create simple verification orders and clinical notes.</p> <p>Develop a team MyDispense case (40 mins) – participants will work in small groups to develop a MyDispense inpatient verification order case that they can incorporate into their own curriculum.</p> <p>Conclusion and Discussion (10 mins) – the session will conclude with a debrief from the speakers and a chance to ask final questions.</p>

Describe how the MyDispense Electronic Health Record (EHR) simulation platform can be used to teach learners how to verify inpatient medication orders 2. Create inpatient verification orders using the MyDispense EHR platform 3. Collaboratively develop a MyDispense case simulating the order verification process that can be incorporated into your own curriculum
