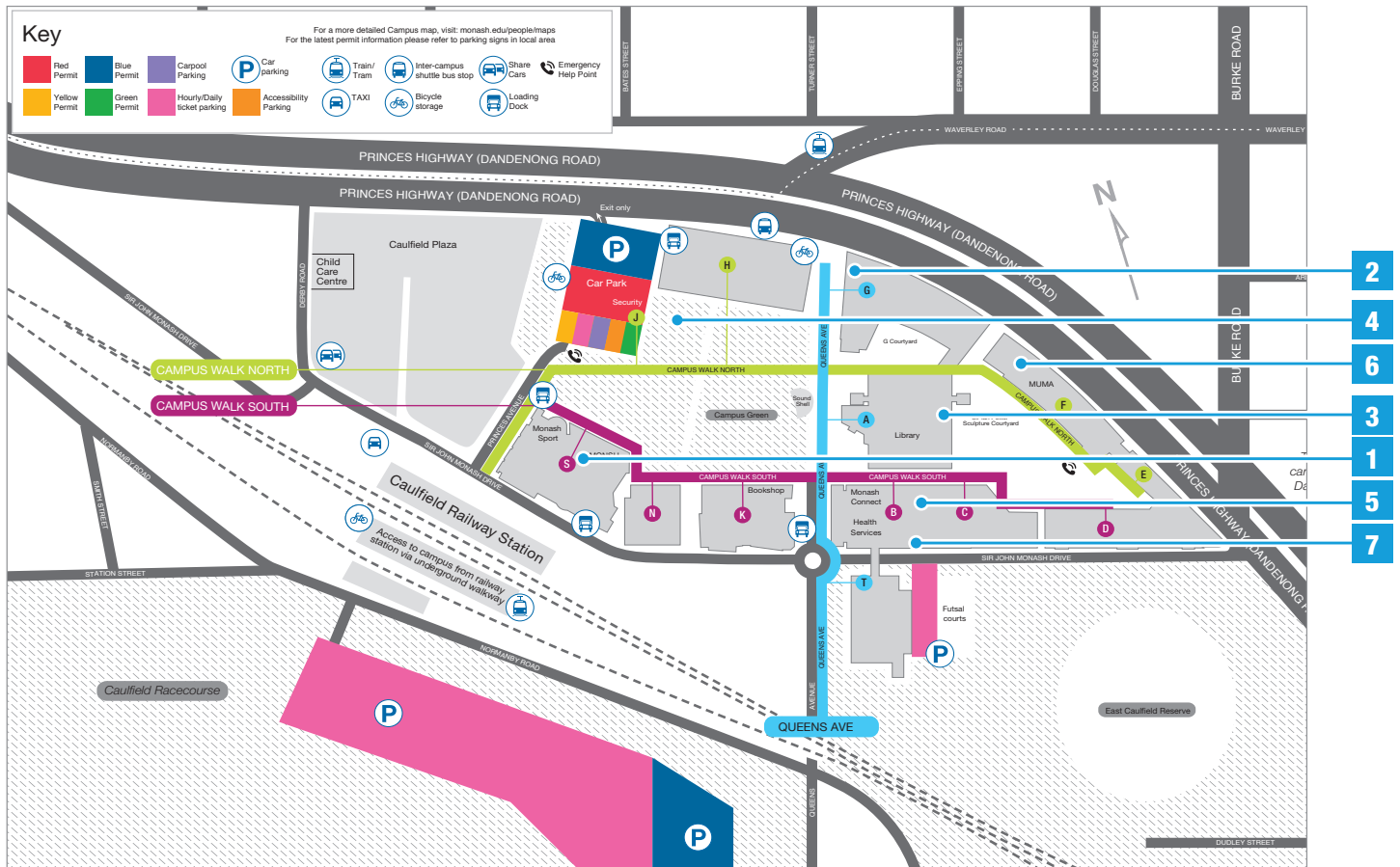

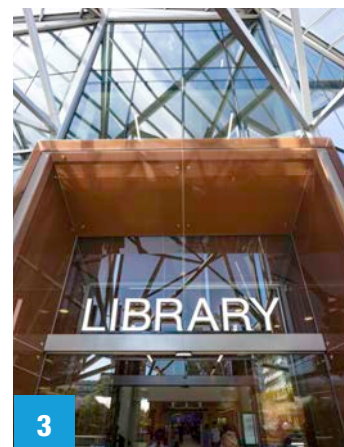

The Sensilab located in Building G is a technology-driven, design-focused research lab. It operates under Monash's Faculty of Information Technology and is housed in the Monash Art, Design and Architecture building

Facilities include immersive visualisation spaces, sound and imaging studios, fabrication areas, a wet lab and a dedicated deep learning supercomputer.
