

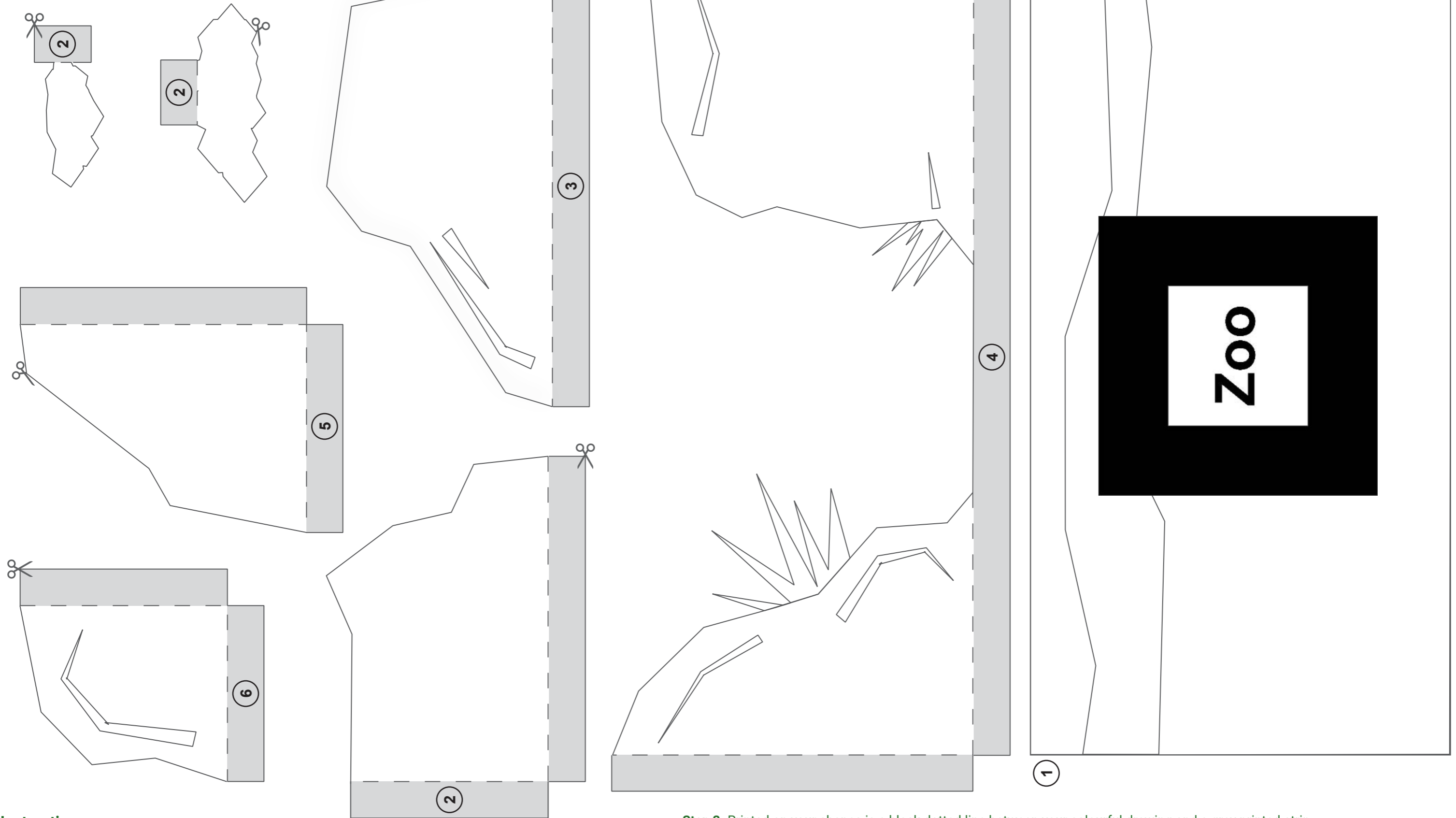

Create your own tissue box habitat



Instructions:

To create your own tissue box habitat, you will need an empty tissue box (a family-sized box works best), this A3 pdf instruction sheet printed, scissors, a glue stick and coloured pencils or textas. We have a short demonstration video to provide further assistance in creating your mini habitat. So be sure to check it out.

Step 1. Colour in the blank landscape shapes of the species habitat with your pencils or textas. The shapes are numbered 1 to 6.

Step 2. Carefully cut around the solid line of the different shapes.

Step 3. Printed on your shapes is a black dotted line between your colourful drawing and a grey printed strip. These grey strips are designed to be stuck onto the sides of the tissue box. Carefully fold along this dotted line on each of your shapes.

Step 4. Use your glue stick to cover the back of shape 1 and paste it to the back wall of your tissue box.

Step 5. Grab your glue stick again add glue to the grey printed strips of shape 2 and paste it within the tissue box. Do the same process with shapes 3 to 6. The demonstration video will help you here and show you where to stick the different shapes within the tissue box.
