**Dr Barrie Kellam**  
*BPharm, PhD, MRPharmS, MRSC*



Dr Barrie Kellam is an Associate Professor in Pharmaceutical Medicinal Chemistry and Chair of the Teaching and Learning Committee at the University of Nottingham's School of Pharmacy, UK.

As part of a series of collaborative relationships between Monash and Nottingham, Dr Kellam recently joined the faculty for a six-month sabbatical. His research career is focused on the synthesis of novel molecular entities and their application to a wide arena of biological and pharmacological problems.

A pharmacist, Dr Kellam is co-founder and Director of Medicinal Chemistry at CellAura Technologies Ltd, a spin-off company from the University of Nottingham that offers innovative fluorescent screening products for life science research and drug discovery.
