Requirements for the Bachelor of Education (Honours)

Specialisation: D30017 Secondary Health and Physical Education

Total credit points: 204 points

Overload: Students are required to overload by 12 points in year 2 to complete the course in 4 years.

First-year requirement: National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (see [Handbook](#) for details)

Themes

1. Education studies: twelve units/72 points

2. Curriculum studies: seven units/42 points

- Students complete:
 - two Secondary method units in HPE: EDF4096 and EDF4097
 - two Secondary [method units](#) (EDF51XX) in the [discipline area](#) in which they are specialising.

3. Discipline studies: fifteen units/90 points

- Students complete:
 - eleven units/66 points in the health and physical education discipline; and
 - four units/24 points in an elected discipline with at least 12 points each at levels 1 and 2.
- HPE discipline academic staff, have identified the following discipline areas as being complementary to this course. As such students may want to consider undertaking their elected discipline studies in one of the following areas:
 - English: four units in literature studies comprising two units at level 1 and two units at level 2
 - Humanities: business, geography, social sciences
 - Mathematics
 - Science: biology, chemistry
- Depending on the discipline area chosen, students may need to complete their discipline units at another Monash campus

4. Professional experience: six professional experience units/80 days of satisfactory teaching practice.

- Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.

Notes:

- This course qualifies students as specialist secondary teachers in three disciplines:
 - Health and Human Development
 - Health and Physical Education
 - The discipline sequence chosen by students qualifies them as specialist secondary teachers in that particular method
