EXPLORING POLYPHARMACY THROUGH THE LENS OF PUBLIC HEALTH: A PERSPECTIVE ON AI-DRIVEN RESEARCH

Professor Caroline Sirois, Université Laval



Caroline Sirois is a pharmacist and tenured professor at the Faculty of Pharmacy at Université Laval in Québec, Canada. She holds a master's degree in hospital pharmacy, a doctorate in pharmacoepidemiology, and a postdoctoral fellowship in epidemiology. Her research interests include multimorbidity, appropriate medication use, polypharmacy, and deprescribing. She is an associated researcher at the National Institute of Public Health of Québec, where she is responsible for population surveillance of polypharmacy. She is interested in various ways of conceptualizing polypharmacy and its impacts from a public health perspective.
