DOUBLE DEGREES	
Stand out in a competitive job market by undertaking a double degree. A double degree doesn't mean double the work. By using the electives from one degree to make up the required units from the other, you'll graduate at least two years sooner than if you studied the courses separately. You can study our Bachelor of Design degree in combination with: + Bachelor of Architectural Studies (only with Communication and Industrial specialisations) + Bachelor of Artificial Intelligence + Bachelor of Arts + Bachelor of Business + Bachelor of Fine Art + Bachelor of Global Studies + Bachelor of Information Technology + Bachelor of Laws (Honours) + Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering (Honours) (only with Industrial specialisation) + Bachelor of Media Communication
