Course requirements for the Bachelor of Education (Honours) and Bachelor of Science

Specialisation: D30052 Secondary Education

1. **Total credit points:** 204 points
2. ***Overload:** To complete the course in 4 years, students are required to overload in year 2 by two units (EDF2088, EDF2099).
 - Students who do not wish to overload in both semesters in year 2 can opt to:
 - a. complete both units during the summer semester at Clayton campus, or
 - b. overload by one unit in year 2 and take one unit in the summer semester at Clayton campus.
 - Students who choose not to overload or study in the summer semester, will extend the duration of their course.
3. **First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (see [Handbook](#) for details).

Core studies	Seven units/42 points
Education studies	Five units/30 points ▪ Students complete a 6 credit point elective unit. You can select a level 2 or 3 unit from across the university in which you are eligible to enrol. You can also select from a range of flagship rich educational experiences (FREE), including the Monash Innovation Guarantee (MIG), Research, Experimentation and Discovery (RED) or volunteering. These FREE units may be credited in place of your free elective if approved by the faculty. ▪ You must discuss your eligibility with your Education Success Adviser (ESA) prior to enrolling in FREE.
Curriculum studies	Six units/36 points ▪ Students complete two pairs of secondary method units (EDF51XX) units corresponding to the discipline studies taken (see discipline studies section below). Refer to the secondary specialist/discipline areas, prerequisites and units.
Discipline studies	Sixteen units/96 points ▪ Students complete the requirements of the Bachelor of Science for their discipline studies. ▪ You should consult the Faculty of Education course adviser regarding your choice of majors and minors within the partner degree course to ensure you are fulfilling the requirements of the Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT). Refer to the secondary specialist/discipline areas prerequisites and units list. ▪ Please note that extended majors are not available in this double degree.
Professional experience	▪ Six professional experience units/80 days of supervised professional experience in secondary schools. ▪ Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.
