What is the study about?

We're asking "Can Psychedelic-Assisted Therapy (PAT) help people on methadone or buprenorphine better manage their non-prescribed opioid use and improve brain health?"

Who can join?

You may be eligible if you:

1. Are between 18 and 60 years old
2. Are currently taking methadone or buprenorphine for Opioid Dependence

When you contact us, our team will answer any questions you have about the study and discuss the other eligibility criteria with you. If needed we will arrange additional health and safety checks.

Will I be paid?

Yes! We'll cover your travel costs and there will be gift vouchers available to thank you for your time.

What will I have to do?



Before enrolment:

To see if this study is right for you, we will ask you some questions about you and check your health.



Measurements for study:

If the study is right for you, you'll be asked to undergo brain scans, thinking tasks and some questionnaires and interviews. These will happen at scheduled times before and after your treatment.



Therapeutic Journey supported by TWO therapists trained in Psychedelic-Assisted Therapy:

Two Preparation Sessions will be provided to prepare you for treatment.

On treatment day, you will be randomly allocated to receive either a high dose or a low dose of the study drug.

Three Integration Sessions are given afterwards to share your experience and insights.



In person visits for follow-up assessments with the study team:

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You'll do a 4-week, 8-week, and 12-week assessment and a final assessment at six months after treatment.
