Course requirements

- Students must complete a total of 48 credit points (cp).

Course notes

- On commencing the course and prior to commencing placement, students must obtain provisional registration with the [Psychology Board of Australia](#). This registration must be maintained for the duration of the course.
- Students may be required to undertake off-campus clinical placement activities.
- Students are required to successfully maintain and complete a practice log and competency journal as part of their course requirements. Both must be submitted to be eligible for course completion.
- Students must complete the professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.
- Students will complete a minimum 300 hours of supervised placement activities throughout the course.
