

MONASH GAO KAO ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

(EFFECTIVE FROM 3rd JULY 2018)

Monash University has revised the Gao Kao undergraduate entry requirements for 2019 intake effective from 3rd July 2018 as detailed in the below table.

The Gao Kao is accepted for entry into most Monash University undergraduate degrees excluding the following courses:

The Gao Kao is also accepted by Monash College for entry into the Monash University Foundation Year (MUFY) and Monash College Diploma Part 1, 1A and 2. For entry into Monash College programs, the revised Gao Kao entry requirements apply for the effective intakes as outlined in the below table. For those students without Gaokao, Monash College continues to accept students with Gao Er into MUFY and Diploma Part 1 or Gao San into all their programs.

^ Calculation methodology:

All students must provide their official final National College Entrance Examination (Gao Kao) issued by the individual Chinese provincial examination authority in order for Monash University/Monash College to establish if you satisfy the above academic entry scores as follows:

Your total marks achieved in the Gao Kao will be converted into a 100% scale by dividing your total marks achieved in the Gao Kao with the maximum score* published by the Department of Education in China for each Chinese province. For example: If you achieved a total mark of 555 in your Gao Kao and the maximum score for Guangdong is 750 the percentage score converted by Monash University/Monash College will be 74%.

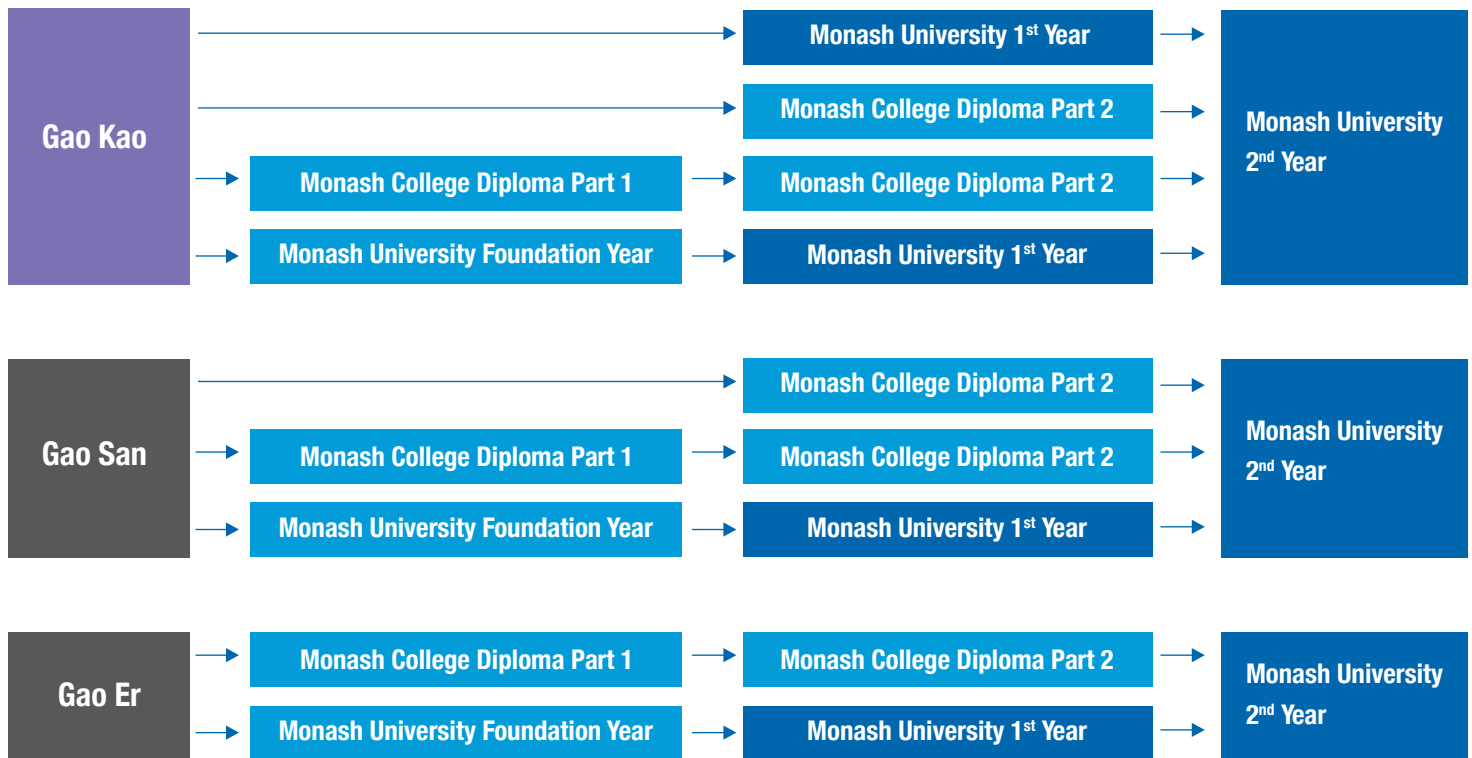
