You'll graduate with the vision to design progressive architecture that responds to the dynamic needs of society and speculates about the future of our built environment.

2 YEAR OR 3 YEAR ENTRY

The Monash University Master of Architecture offers a new entry option, open to graduates of any Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent). This means in 3 years, coming from any disciplinary background, you can graduate with the professional exit degree required for registration as an Architect. Previously only graduates with a Bachelor of Architectural Design (or equivalent) could enter the Master degree - which they still can, completing in 2 years.

Whether you've completed undergraduate studies in architecture or in another field, the Master of Architecture meets the academic requirements necessary to register as an Architect.

Central to the Monash program is our project-based design studios, which address a wide range of architectural issues and challenges, including housing, urban design, digital practice, evolving construction methods and design speculation. All studios are taught by Monash academics alongside leading architectural practitioners, ensuring that you are exposed to current industry practice. Each semester you can select studios from the many on offer allowing you to follow your interests and passions.

Monash Architecture values and encompasses multi-disciplinary collaborative practice and community involvement in the design process.

ACCREDITATION

The Master of Architecture degree meets the knowledge and skills required for professional recognition by the Architects Accreditation Council of Australia (AACA) and the Australian Institute of Architects. To register as an Architect, graduates must also complete two years of professional practice and pass the AACA Architectural Practice Examination. COURSE STRUCTURE

An integrated program of study allows you to select from a range of design studios in conjunction with advanced architectural studies. Complementary units introduce the methods and tactics of architectural design research and engage with the multidisciplinary socio-cultural, political, economic, historical, theoretical and technical dimensions relevant to contemporary architecture and urbanism.

WHO WE'RE LOOKING FOR

Applicants for the **2 year Master** degree are welcome from anyone with an Australian Bachelor of Architectural Design (or equivalent).

Applicants for the **3 year Master** of Architecture are welcome from a diverse range of disciplines. You will study with a multidisciplinary cohort who will enrich and enliven your own experience. So, if you have studied Design, Business, Economics, Environmental Science, Landscape Architecture, Engineering, Mathematics, IT, Geography, International Development, Physical Science or Fine Art then we are interested in you.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

2 year entry: An Australian Bachelor of Architectural Design (or equivalent) with at least a distinction average (70 per cent). Applicants must provide a design folio and CV along with their application. Shortlisted applicants may be invited for an interview.

3 year entry: An Australian undergraduate degree (or equivalent) with at least distinction average (70 per cent). Applicants must provide a short folio showing their past creative work (in any form or medium), a CV and a statement of why they are interested in the program. Shortlisted applicants may be invited for an interview.
