She was part of one of the largest UK investments in the evidence use landscape, the ESRC Centre for Evidence Based Policy and Practice and a Founding Editor of the Journal Evidence & Policy. She has undertaken an international leadership role in promoting the use of evidence, recently publishing a new book on evidence use 'What Works Now' and co-leading Transforming Evidence with Kathryn Oliver.

Annette is a member of the WHO European Advisory Committee on Health Research and advises WHO on a number of international projects.
