Pathways to Monash degrees

- If you pass all units in the Diploma of Tertiary Studies – Nursing stream having passed all units on the first (and only) attempt with a minimum weighted average mark of at least 55%, you will receive a guaranteed place and an offer from Monash into course [M2006](#) Bachelor of Nursing. Students who do not reach this requirement will need to apply for a place via VTAC (this is a competitive process and applicants will need an average of at least 60%, including scores from any failed units).
