

YEAR 12 CHEMISTRY HPLC REVISION WORKSHOPS

Monash University's Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences invites Year 12 Chemistry students to our Parkville campus to participate in a hands-on HPLC workshop. The session allows students to operate analytical instruments, design their own investigation and revise keys concepts that are examined in their Unit 4 assessment.

During this workshop, students will:

- Receive an introduction lesson to HPLC instruments, techniques and theory from current Pharmaceutical Science PhD students
- Create a calibration curve using a HPLC instrument
- Design and perform a quantitative HPLC investigation

Please note: Four repeats of this 3.5 hr workshop will be run with a maximum of 25 students in each group.

A limited number of places in this workshop will be provided free of charge to students who attend a Monash under-represented school or are from a low income household.
