

## L3006 Bachelor of Laws (Honours) and Bachelor of Music (BMus/LLB) 2015 Course Map

**Bachelor of Laws (Honours)** 17 common core units (102 credit points) + 9 elective units (54 credit points) including **one** commercial law elective and **one** research project unit = **Total of 156 points.**

**Bachelor of Music** 12 compulsory units (72 points) + 4 electives (24 points) = **Total of 96 points**

**Double degree – total credit points = 96 + 156 = 252 credit points**
