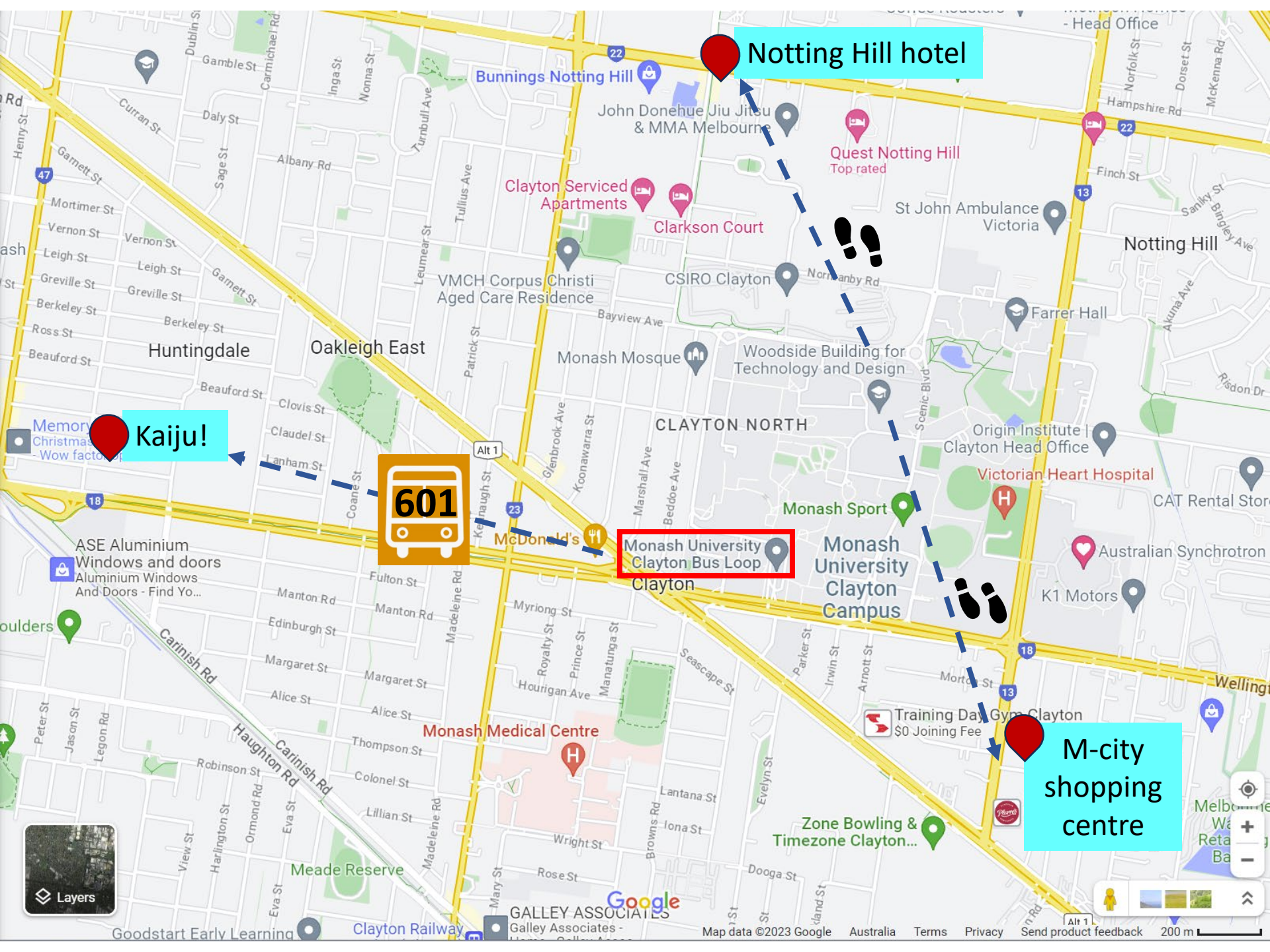

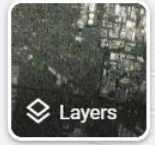

- [Notting Hill Hotel](#) (Lunch, Dinner & Drinks) - "A staple for students and academics at Monash. A 15 minute walk from campus, but only a 4 minute drive. Head West out of the Woodside Building and follow Alliance Lane North until it reaches Research Way. Follow Research Way West out of the University and then turn North onto Gardiner Road. Follow this road North until you meet the corner with Ferntree Gully Road and you will have arrived!"
- [Kaiju Cantina](#) (Lunch, Dinner & Drinks) - "A local craft brewery with ties to Monash. Located at 27 Hume Street in Huntingdale, the brewery is an 8 minute drive or a 10 minute bus (head down to the Monash Bus Loop and catch the 601 to Huntingdale Station, then walk 2 minutes to the address).
- [MCity Food Court](#) (Lunch & Dinner, Bar located upstairs for Drinks) - "MCity is the second shopping centre next to Monash and is a 6 minute drive or 20 minute walk. Head south out of the University and walk East along Wellington Road until you reach the intersection with Blackburn Road. Follow Blackburn Road South until you reach MCity!"
- [Pinewood Dumpling & Ramen House](#) (Lunch & Dinner) - "Located at Pinewood Shopping Centre and only a 7 minute drive or 10 minute bus ride away. Head to the Monash Bus Loop and take the 703 or 737 and get off at Pinewood Shopping Centre."

Getting around by public transport in Victoria:

1) Get your Myki card

The three main modes of public transport (buses, trams and trains) are integrated, and travel requires only one Myki card.

This card can be purchased from physical stores (train stations or 7-Elevens) or from your smartphone.
