Requirements for the Master of Teaching

Specialisation: D60014 Primary and Secondary Education

Total credit points: 96 points

1. Coursework units: sixteen units/96 points

2. Professional experience units: four units/60 days of satisfactory professional experience

- Students must complete a compulsory orientation before undertaking any professional experience.
- Students who wish to meet current AITSL skill assessment requirements for secondary teachers have the option to take EDF5991 Secondary professional experience 1C. This unit provides for an additional 15 days of professional experience in a secondary setting for international students. Students are advised to independently check AITSL skill assessment requirements.
