STUDIO-BASED LEARNING

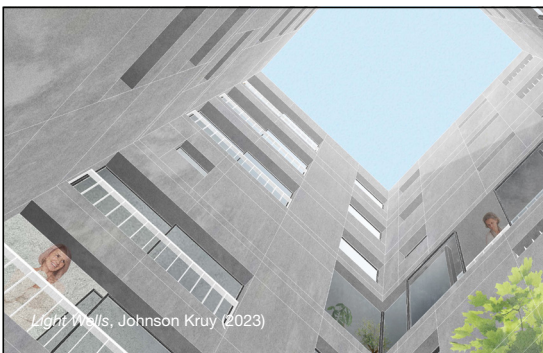
More than half of your degree will be spent in the studio guided by industry experts and academics. You will work on real projects in a small-class environment to develop responses to a wide range of social and spatial issues.

DOUBLE DEGREES

You can add to your architectural design degree by combining either **Bachelor of Architectural Design** with the **Bachelor of Civil Engineering (Honours)**.

Rather than four years of study, with an additional two years, you will graduate with two bachelor degrees.
