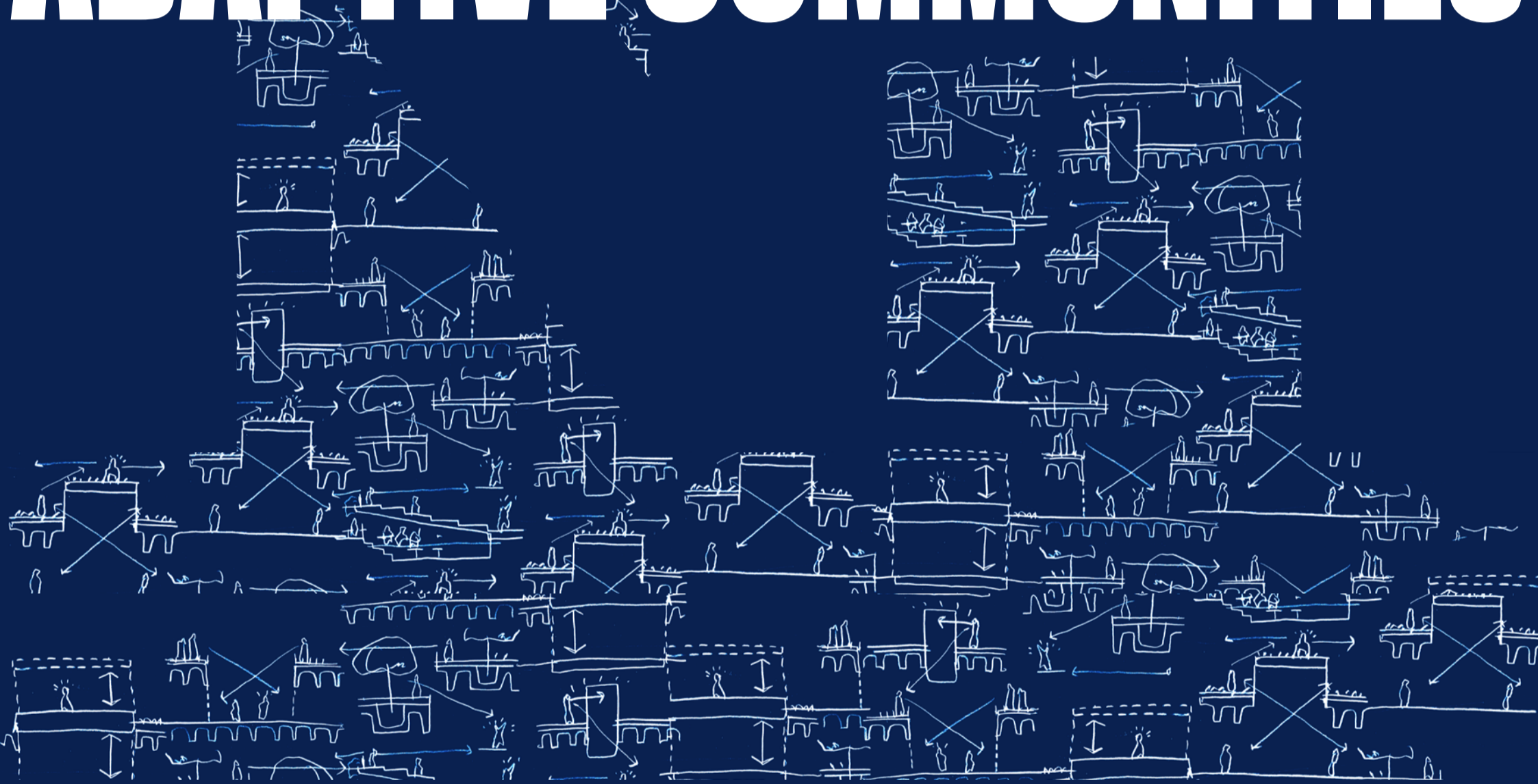


ADAPTIVE COMMUNITIES

Adaptive Communities explores contemporary approaches to social housing through the design methodology of NH Architecture. Drawing on the practice's research and direct experience within the typology, the studio challenges students to design adaptable, people focused environments that respond to diverse user groups.

Students will investigate equitable design, safety, community connection, adaptability and sustainability - forming a clear design position early in the semester. Working across scales, from masterplanning to detailed architectural moments, they will test how a strong central idea carries through every decision. Diagramming will act as a primary tool, ensuring ideas are not only conceived - but clearly communicated.
