

Monash University MMR Training Program Key Dates 2027

The following document summarises the key dates for **new MMR Pharmacists** seeking to enrol in the Monash University MMR Training Program (MUMTP) in **2027**.

If you are eligible for our recognition of prior learning (RPL) pathway (i.e. currently credentialed MMR pharmacist) or if you have completed elements of the MUMTP during the Intern Foundation Program (IFP), please contact us at pharmacy.microcredentials@monash.edu for information about dates that are suitable for you.

New MMR Pharmacists Pathway

What are the key dates for the program?

There will be two enrolment intakes into the MMR training program for 2027.

Intake 1 (January 2027)

Enrolment and Conclusion

Enrolments for new MMR pharmacists open	Monday 14 th December 2026
Enrolments for new MMR pharmacists close	Sunday 31 st January 2027
MUMTP concludes (Final assessment deadline)	Thursday 30 th September 2027

Learners can commence the program once they have successfully enrolled.

Step 1 – Online learning (assessment dates)

To help ensure learners are prepared for the workshops and simulated assessments, we request that assessments associated with the online learning material are completed by the deadline below. Requests for extensions/special consideration must be made at least 2 working days prior to this deadline.

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Step 2a – Simulation Workshop Dates

New MMR pharmacist learners are required to attend two simulation workshops (workshop 1 and 2) to practice their MMR skills. Workshops are delivered online via Zoom

Workshop 1: RMMRs	Wednesday 3 rd March 2027 7-9pm (AEDT)
Workshop 2: HMRs	Wednesday 10 th March 2027 7-9pm (AEDT)

Step 2b – Simulated assessments

All new MMR pharmacist learners will be required to complete an Observed Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE). This is an oral examination conducted over Zoom during which learners will be assessed on their history taking skills and communication in the context of a simulated MMR.

New learners must sign up for ONE of the following dates/times. Learners will be asked to sign up to a ONE-hour OSCE session via an online booking system within the morning or afternoon session times advertised. Learners can change their session time up until the closing date pending availability. Every effort will be made to accommodate the learners' preferred date, sign-ups for available sessions **will close 10 days prior to the advertised dates.**

Step 3 – Experiential learning

All new MMR pharmacist learners will be required to complete an MMR visit under the supervision of a credentialed MMR pharmacist who meets specific eligibility criteria. These supervised visits are expected to take place between April and August 2027.

Intake 2 (April 2027)

Enrolment and Conclusion

Enrolments for new MMR pharmacists open	Monday 15 th March 2027
Enrolments for new MMR pharmacists close	Sunday 18 th April 2027
MUMTP concludes (Final assessment deadline)	Friday 27 th November 2027

Learners can commence the program once they have successfully enrolled.

Step 1 – Online learning (assessment dates)

To help ensure learners are prepared for the workshops and simulated assessments, we request that assessments associated with the online learning material are completed by the deadline below. Requests for extensions/special consideration must be made at least 2 working days prior to this deadline.

Workshop 2: HMRs	Wednesday 26 th May 2027 7-9pm (AEST)

Step 2b – Simulated assessments

All new MMR pharmacist learners will be required to complete an Observed Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE). This is an oral examination conducted over Zoom during which learners will be assessed on their history taking skills and communication in the context of a simulated MMR.

New learners must sign up for ONE of the following dates/times. Learners will be asked to sign up to a ONE-hour OSCE session via an online booking system within the morning or afternoon session times advertised. Learners can change their session time up until the closing date pending availability. Every effort will be made to accommodate the learners' preferred date, sign-ups for available sessions **will close 10 days prior to the advertised dates.**

Step 3 – Experiential learning
