- Clinical placement activities are undertaken throughout the course and extend beyond the start and end dates of each semester. [EDF5517](#) is a full-year unit during which students undertake and record the completion of the required clinical placement activities and attend supervision sessions. Part-time students participate but do not enrol in [EDF5517](#) in first semester of Year 1 and participate and enrol in the unit in second semester of Year 2.
