

Registry Milestone with 202 Surgeons Contributing from 140 Hospitals

Another significant milestone has been reached by the Bariatric Surgery Registry. The number of surgeons who are actively contributing their data to the Registry has surpassed **200** for the first time in the project's history. Having nearly 80% of those doing bariatric surgery across Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand taking part demonstrates the very high level of support for the Registry from the profession. The number of hospitals represented by these surgeons has grown to 140, also an all-time high.

Surgeon Reports

Individual surgeon reports based on the same data set as the annual report for the first time will be posted in the coming weeks. To be eligible for a report, surgeons need to have sufficient operation and follow-up data entered in the Registry for the reporting period (at the time the data for the annual report was extracted in November 2021).

The Registry congratulates PhD Candidate and Research Assistant Ms Alyssa Budin on her recent publication in *Obesity Surgery* 'Surgeon Engagement with Patient-Reported Measures in Australian and Aotearoa New Zealand Bariatric Practices'. The publication is based on Ms Budin's initial part of her PhD which will ultimately lead to the collection of patient-reported outcomes in the Bariatric Surgery Registry.

Participating surgeons are invited to contribute to Ms Budin's upcoming project which will assess changes in participants' quality of life, psychological well-being, addictive eating and substance use behaviours from pre-surgery to 3 years post-operatively. Registry Workshop at ANZMOSS

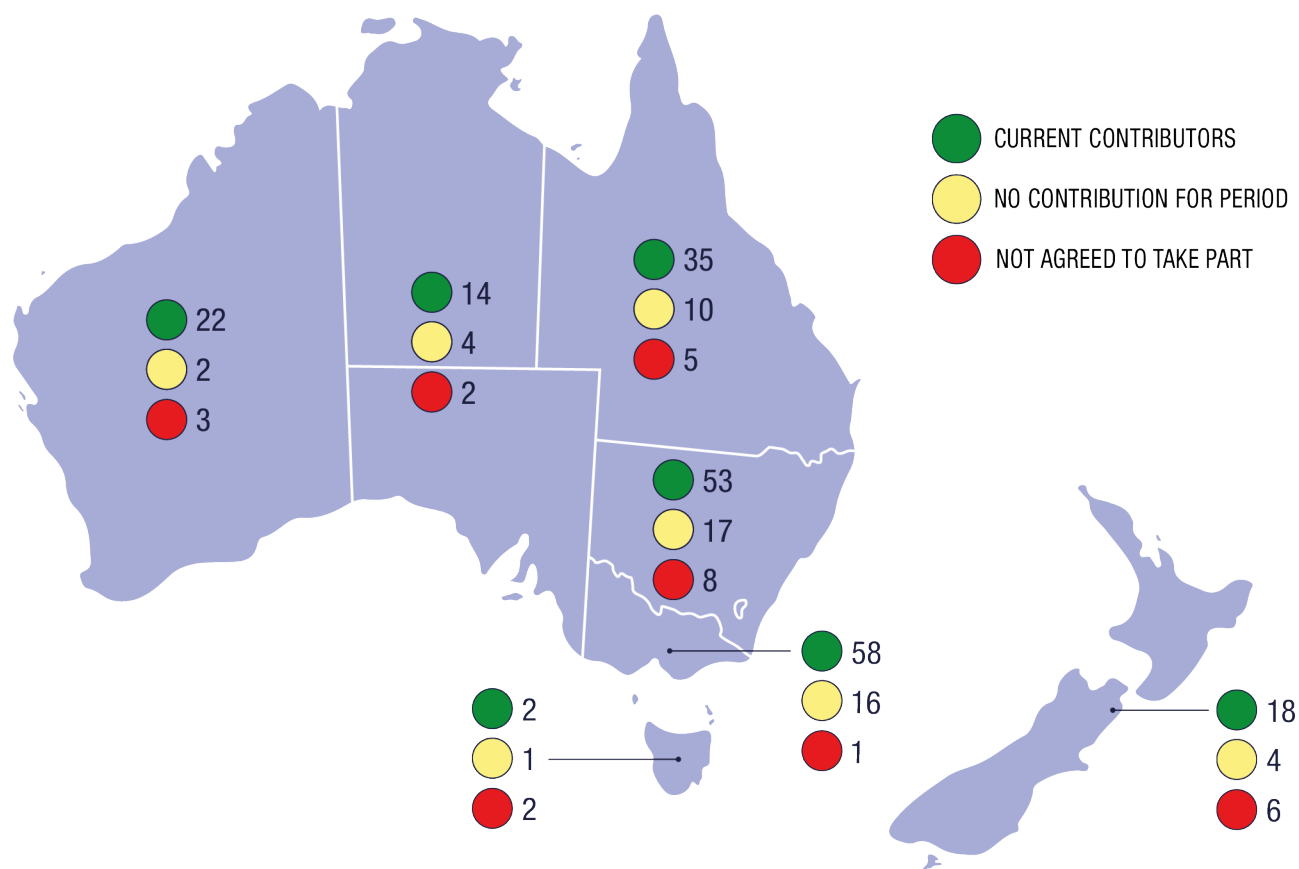
