## Requirements for the Bachelor of Education (Honours) and Bachelor of Business Specialisation: D30071 Primary Education

**Total credit points:** 204 points

**Overload:** Students are required to overload by 12 points in year 2 to complete the course in 4 years.

**First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (see [Handbook](#) for details)

**1. Education studies:** six units/36 points

**2. Curriculum studies:** twelve units/72 points

- EDF4009 English and literacies 4
- EDF4047 Leading literacy learning

#### *Mathematics and numeracy*

- EDF2066 Mathematics 1
- EDF3067 Mathematics 2
- EDF4078 Leading mathematics learning

**3. Discipline studies:** sixteen units/96 points undertaken within the [Bachelor of Business](#).
