### Specialisation: D30041 Primary Education and Music Performance/Composition and Music Technology/Popular Music

1. **Total credit points:** 204 points
2. **\*Overload:** To complete the course in 4 years, students are required to overload in year 2 by two units (EDF2088, EDF2099).
  - Students who do not wish to overload in both semesters in year 2 can opt to:
    - a. complete both units during the summer semester at Clayton campus, or
    - b. overload by one unit in year 2 and take one unit in the summer semester at Clayton campus.
  - Students who choose not to overload or study in the summer semester, will extend the duration of their course.
3. **First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (see [Handbook](#) for details).
