

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND AUTHORSHIP

### GUIDELINES FOR PROVISION OF DATA FROM THE BURN REGISTRY OF AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND (BRANZ)

- BRANZ is a valuable source of data about burns patients across Australia and New Zealand. Access to the data and requests for data from the BRANZ database is subject to strict access guidelines (see Guidelines for Access to Data Collected by the *Burns Registry of Australia and New Zealand*).
- Any data provided to you is extracted and supplied on the condition that the BRANZ will be acknowledged as the source of the data.
- The following acknowledgement must be included in any and all publications, presentations, or media releases that arise from data provided by the BRANZ:

“The BRANZ has received funding from the Australian and New Zealand Burn Association (ANZBA), the Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Health Care (2008-2009), the Julian Burton Burns Trust (2008-2013), the Helen Macpherson Smith Trust (2010-2012), the Thyne Reid Foundation (2011-2013), the Australasian Foundation for Plastic Surgery (2013-2017), the New Zealand Accident Compensation Corporation (2013-2026), the Clipsal by Schneider Electric National Community Grants Program (2017), the HCF Research Foundation (2018-2019), and the Victorian Agency for Health Information (2021-2022). - It is required that at least one member of the BRANZ Steering Committee is included as a collaborator on any project or co-author on any publication arising from the use of BRANZ data. Including a member of the BRANZ Steering Committee as a collaborator and co-author improves understanding of how the data will be used and reduces the risk of inaccurate interpretation of results. This is especially pertinent in cases where data is used for a student project.
- Projects using data from both Australian and New Zealand services are required to include at least one New Zealand-based advisor and/or co-author.
- A copy of any document or presentation in which you use data provided by the BRANZ should be provided to the registry in a timely fashion following publication/presentation. The BRANZ maintains a record of all requests for registry data and its subsequent use as a means of monitoring its use by those interested in burns data.
