

SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE TEST (SAT)

REQUIRED SCORE

A minimum score of 1220* for entry into the Bachelor of Science. A higher score may be required for other science courses.

REQUIRED SUBJECTS

You must satisfy the following prerequisite subject requirements for this course, at the required level:

- **ENGLISH**
 - SAT examination cannot be used to satisfy the English language requirement. An approved high school diploma or English test may be required.
- **MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE**
 - A score of 550 in the 'Math' section completed during the SAT examination.
 - The SAT examination cannot be used to satisfy science prerequisites for any Monash undergraduate courses.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Total score by adding the best section scores achieved in 'Evidence Based Reading and Writing' and 'Math' as awarded on the SAT Score Report* issued by the College Board.

An official final academic transcript and evidence of successful completion of a Monash approved senior secondary school leaving qualification must also be provided (additional guidelines may apply).

All SAT examinations submitted to Monash University will be considered when calculating the entry score, provided the SAT is marked out of 1600.
