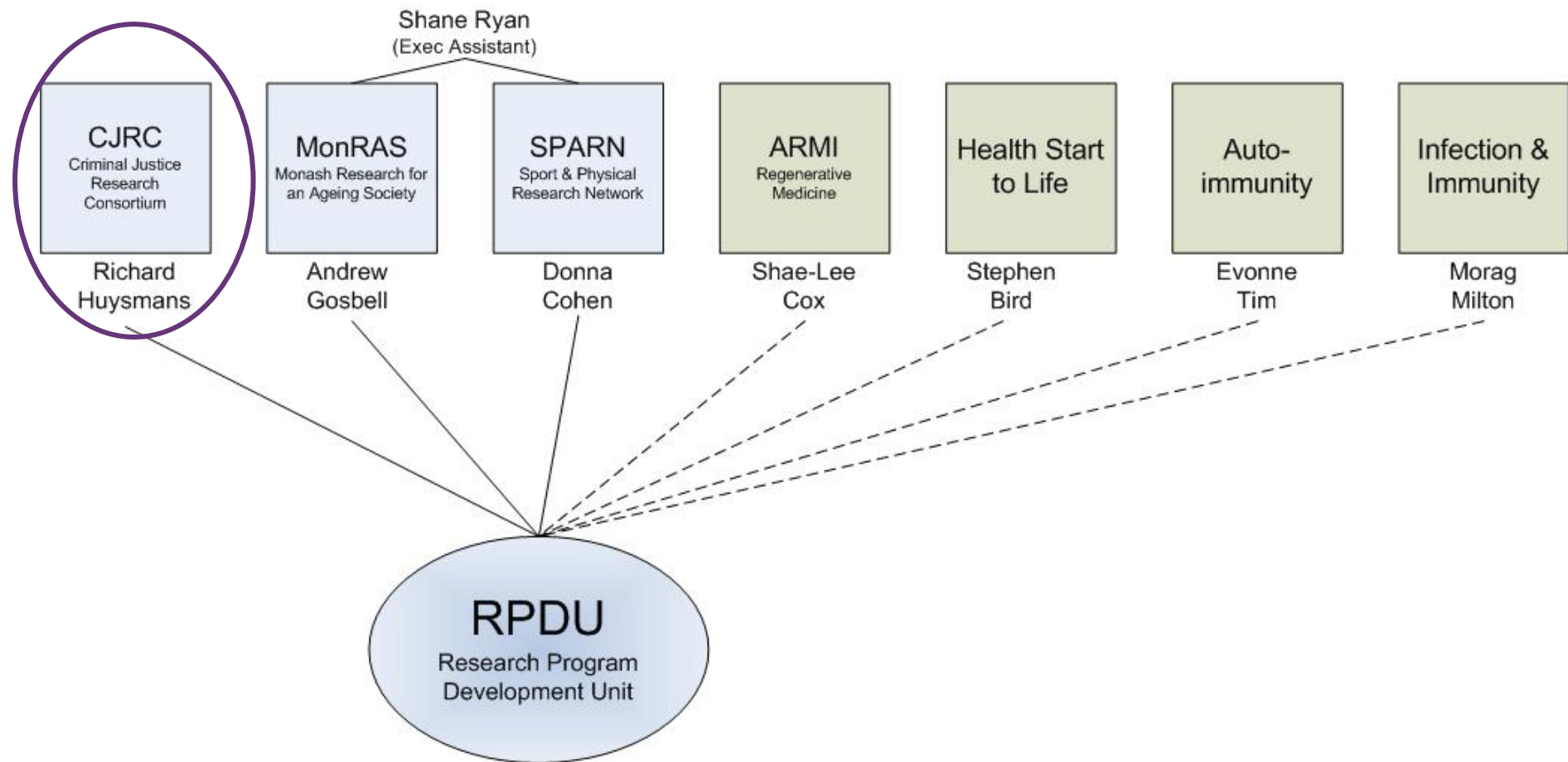

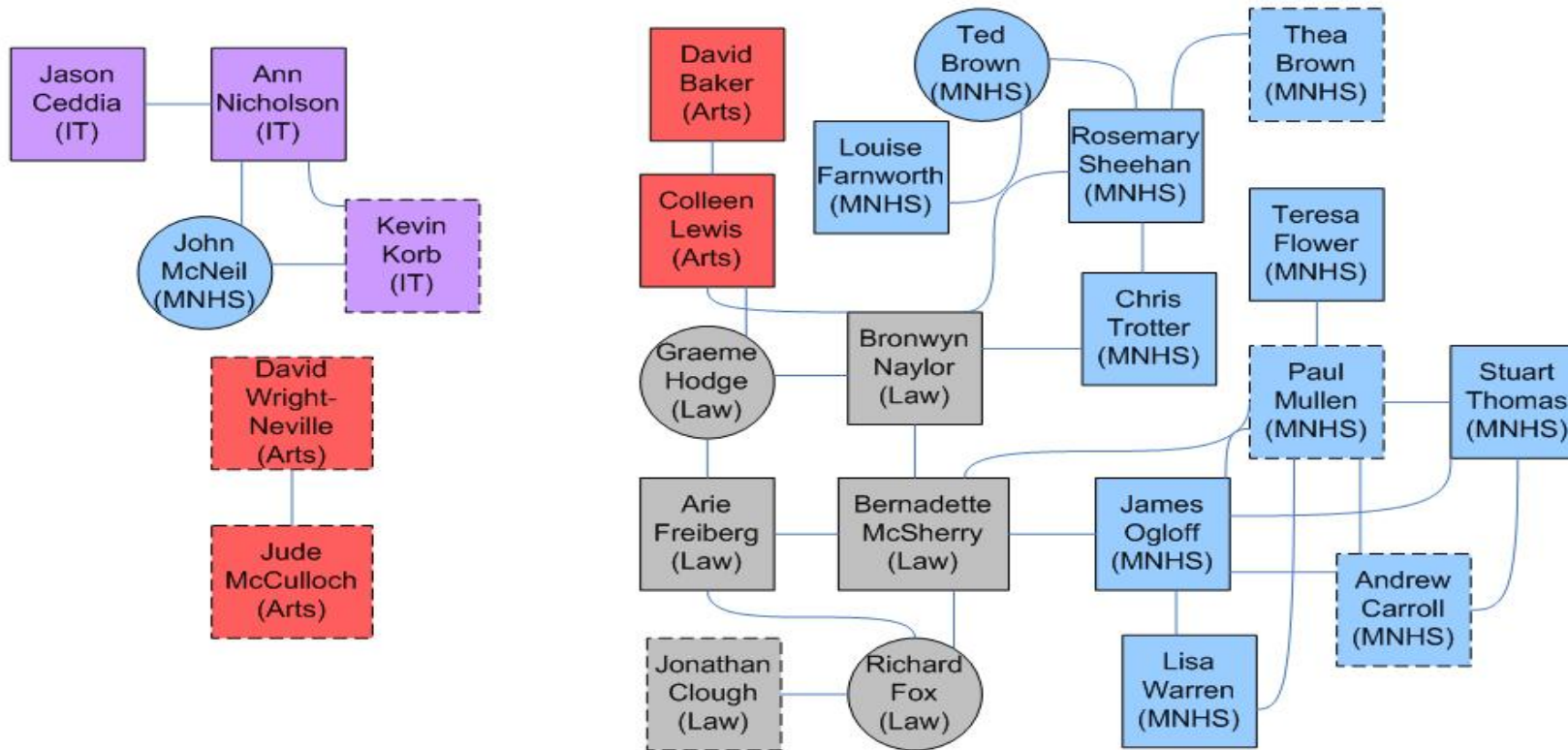
CJRC workshop objectives

- **Discuss and decide on CJRC functions.**

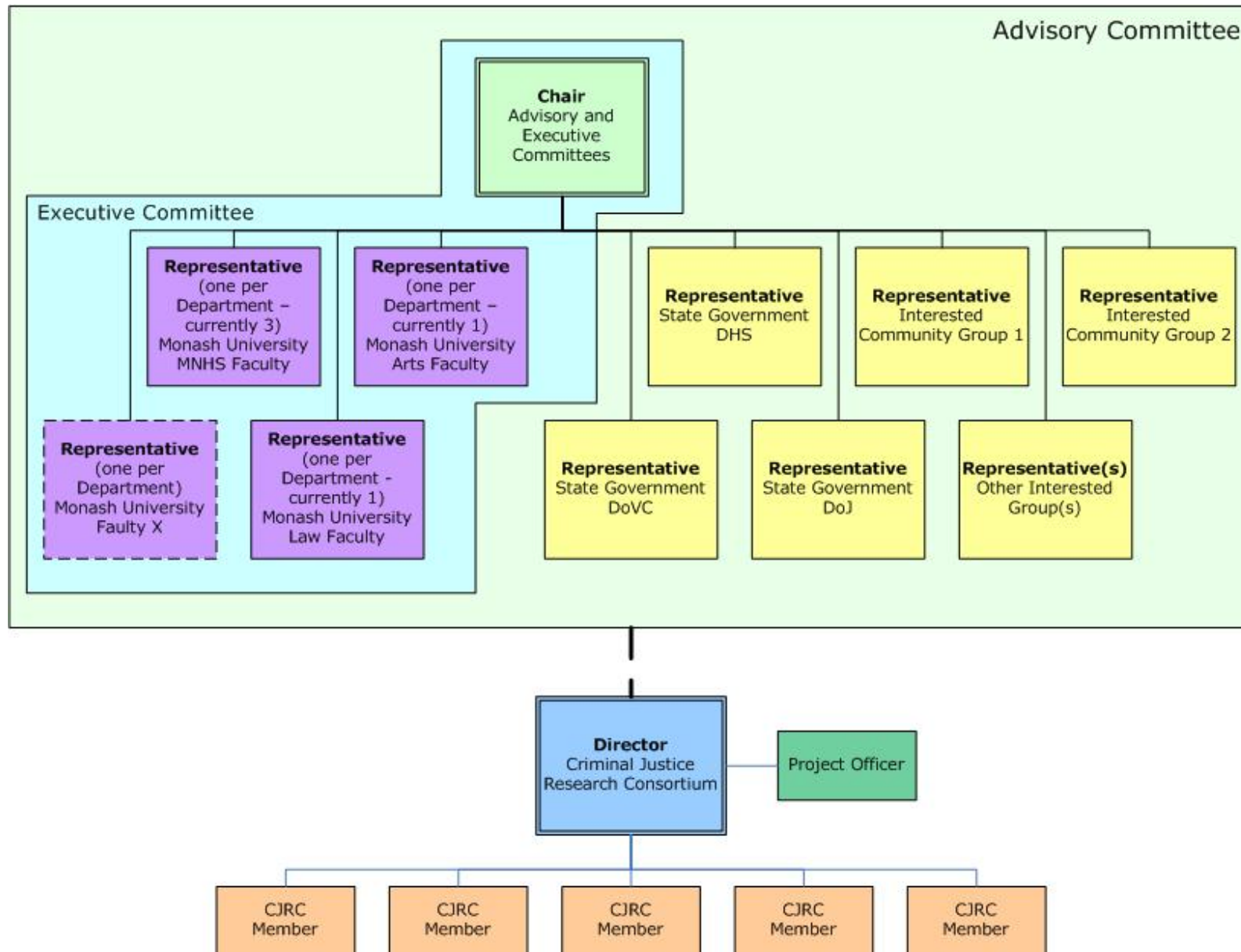
The CJRC is one of a number of new initiatives
