The school has a footprint extending from Mildura in the north-west to Bairnsdale in the south-east. Our main teaching sites are co-located with regional hospitals and we have partnerships with community-based health services in rural and regional locations across our footprint.

SIP rotations are available at all our major teaching sites and some of our community-based partner sites.
