

Frequently Asked Questions

Quality Supervision Course

Do I need to complete the course workshop component if I have completed both of the free supervision workshops funded by the Victorian DHHS?

No, you have completed the prerequisite workshop component and only need to register for the assessment component.

Do I need to complete the course workshop component if I have completed similar training from another provider?

We will assess these applications on an individual basis, you will be required to provide details on the course date, location, provider, content, duration and learning outcomes (if available).

Do I need to be supervising at the time of enrolment?

It will be helpful if you are supervising students and/or peers/colleagues when you are completing the first 12 weeks of the assessment component as you will be required to submit a weekly diary on your supervision practice.

I supervise Monash University students, what do I need to submit to be eligible for a discounted place?

You will need to submit correspondence from your placement coordinator (or similar) that you have supervised students from Monash University and will continue to do so in the future. This will need to be submitted at registration and you will be notified if this registration has been accepted. Please note these places are extremely limited and will be offered on a first-in basis.

What is the workload requirement for the assessment component?

Supervision short-course:

- Two half days of online training or online workshop (if not already completed an approved equivalent).

Assessment Component:

- Reflection on short-course, 1000 words (approx. 10 hours)
- Weekly submission of a 5-10 minute audio diary for 12 weeks then a short reflection of feedback received (approx. 5 hours)
- Review and provide weekly feedback on the supervision diary of a peer for 12 weeks (approx. 10 hours)
- Implementation of feedback in supervisory practice (approx. 15 hours)
- Analytical paper, 3500 words (approx. 20 hours).
