This studio is set in the community of Wurrumiyanga on the Tiwi Islands, in the Northern Territory, where AFL plays a central role in community life and social connection. Students will learn from The Fulcrum Agency's approach to community led design, working with Mantiyupwi Traditional owners to develop proposals for a Sporting complex. The facility will host matches for the Tiwi Bombers Football Club with player facilities, spectator seating and facilities, social club and community facilities. There will be provision for a year-round training facility that will double as a cyclone shelter for the community.

Designs will respond to Tiwi culture and the tropical climate, considering approaches to construction suitable for remote contexts, and address budget, durability and inclusivity. Studio outputs will include research and mapping, architectural drawings, model making and material studies, with an emphasis on communication techniques that resonate with community representatives.

An optional short field trip to Wurrumiyanga is planned for Week 6, costs including flights to Darwin, ferry and accommodation are estimated to be around \$1,000
