Course requirements

1. **Total credit points:** 204 cp (all units are 6 cp unless otherwise specified)
2. ***Overload:** To complete the course in 4 years, students are required to overload in year 2 by two units (EDF2088, EDF2099).
 - Students who do not wish to overload in both semesters in year 2 can opt to:
 - a. complete both units during the summer semester at Clayton campus, or
 - b. overload by one unit in year 2 and take one unit in the summer semester at Clayton campus.
 - Students who choose not to overload or study in the summer semester, will extend the duration of their course.
3. **First-year requirement:** National Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students. The Faculty of Education's [LANTITE page](#) has more information on this test.

Core studies	Seven units/42 cp
Education studies	Five units/30 cp ▪ Students complete a 6 cp elective unit. You can select a level 2 or 3 unit from across the university in which you are eligible to enrol. You can also select from a range of flagship rich educational experiences (FREE), including the Monash Innovation Guarantee (MIG), Research, Experimentation and Discovery (RED) or volunteering. These FREE units may be credited in place of your free elective if approved by the faculty. ▪ You must discuss your eligibility with your Education Success Adviser (ESA) prior to enrolling in FREE.
Curriculum studies	Six units/36 cp ▪ Students complete two pairs of Secondary method units (EDF51XX) in the discipline areas in which they are specialising.
Discipline studies	16 units/96 cp ▪ Students complete the requirements of the Bachelor of Business for their discipline studies. The secondary discipline areas by course document shows you which secondary teaching areas you can choose from. ▪ #Please refer to the B2000 Handbook entry for information regarding the units required for Professional Accounting Accreditation. ▪ *If you are completing the Accounting major as part of your double degree, please note ECX2953 is required for professional accreditation and can be completed in Part A instead of ECF1100, and you will not be required to complete ECF1200. ▪ ^Business specified unit: EDF3062 Creative and critical teaching meets this requirement; you are required to choose another 6 cp unit from the Accounting, Business law, Business management or Economics and business strategy majors.
Professional experience	▪ Six professional experience units/80 days of supervised professional experience in secondary schools. ▪ Students must complete professional experience orientation provided by the faculty prior to undertaking any professional experience.
