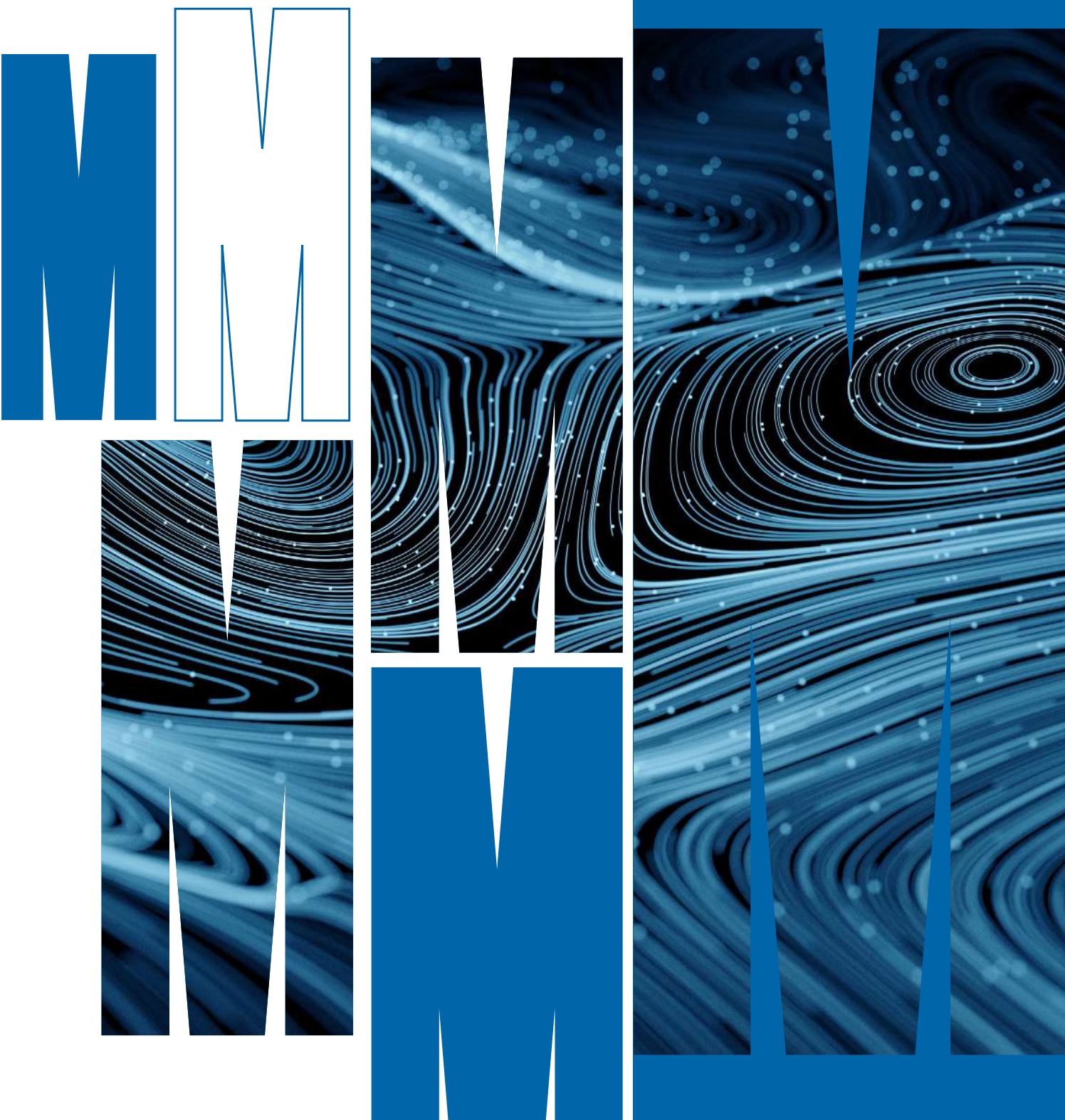

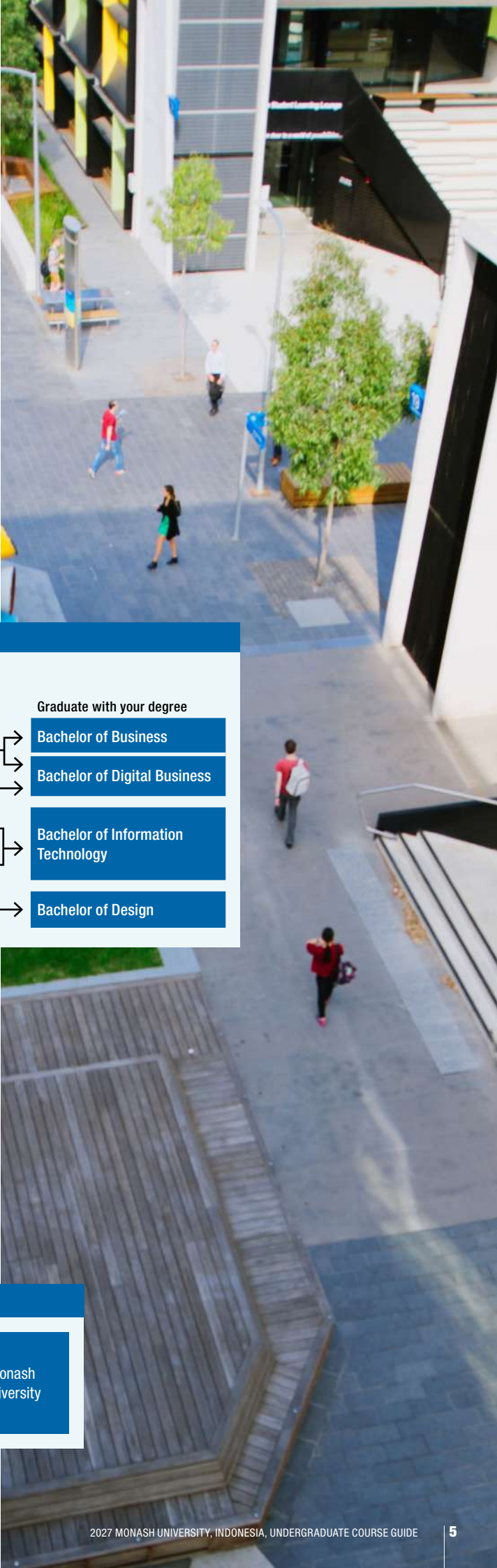

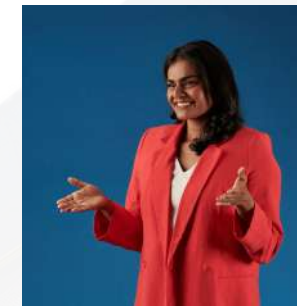

MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

We believe in rewarding your hard work from day one. Our entry scholarships are awarded across three tiers based on your academic achievements before joining Monash. This financial support is applied directly to your first-year tuition fees, spread evenly across your first two semesters.

Eligibility

You must meet the minimum score requirements in your final Year 12 results. To view the specific entry requirements for your high school curriculum, simply scan the QR code or visit our website.

Benefits

You'll receive a reduced tuition fee tier, determined by your previous academic achievements.

You'll be automatically assessed for this scholarship when you apply for an eligible undergraduate program at Monash University Indonesia – no separate application is required¹.

VICE-CHANCELLOR'S PROGRESSION SCHOLARSHIP

Designed to support our most dedicated students, this scholarship rewards your continued academic commitment as you advance through your studies with us.

Eligibility

To qualify for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a current Monash University, Indonesia, undergraduate student who has achieved the required WAM
- Be continuing your full-time studies with us into your second or third year
- Maintain a strong academic standing with no failed units.

Benefits

Your academic performance in the preceding year will directly impact your award value. Based on your Weighted Average Mark (WAM), you can secure a scholarship tier of up to IDR 20 million:

- 60% WAM: IDR 10,000,000
- 70% WAM: IDR 15,000,000
- 80% WAM: IDR 20,000,000

You don't need to apply for this award. You'll be automatically assessed upon the completion of your first full academic year (48 credit points) to see if you qualify.

Exclusions

Please note, this scholarship is not applicable to:

- Students already holding a full-duration Monash scholarship (such as our 10% or 20% tuition fee reductions)
- Transfer students or those enrolled in a 1.5 + 1.5 packaged degree pathway between Indonesia and Australia
- Government/company sponsorships.

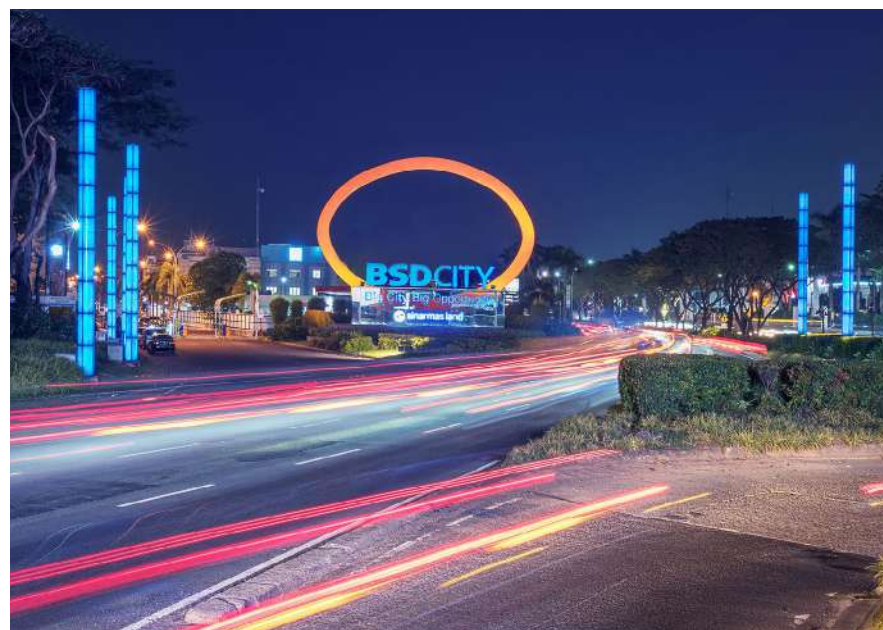
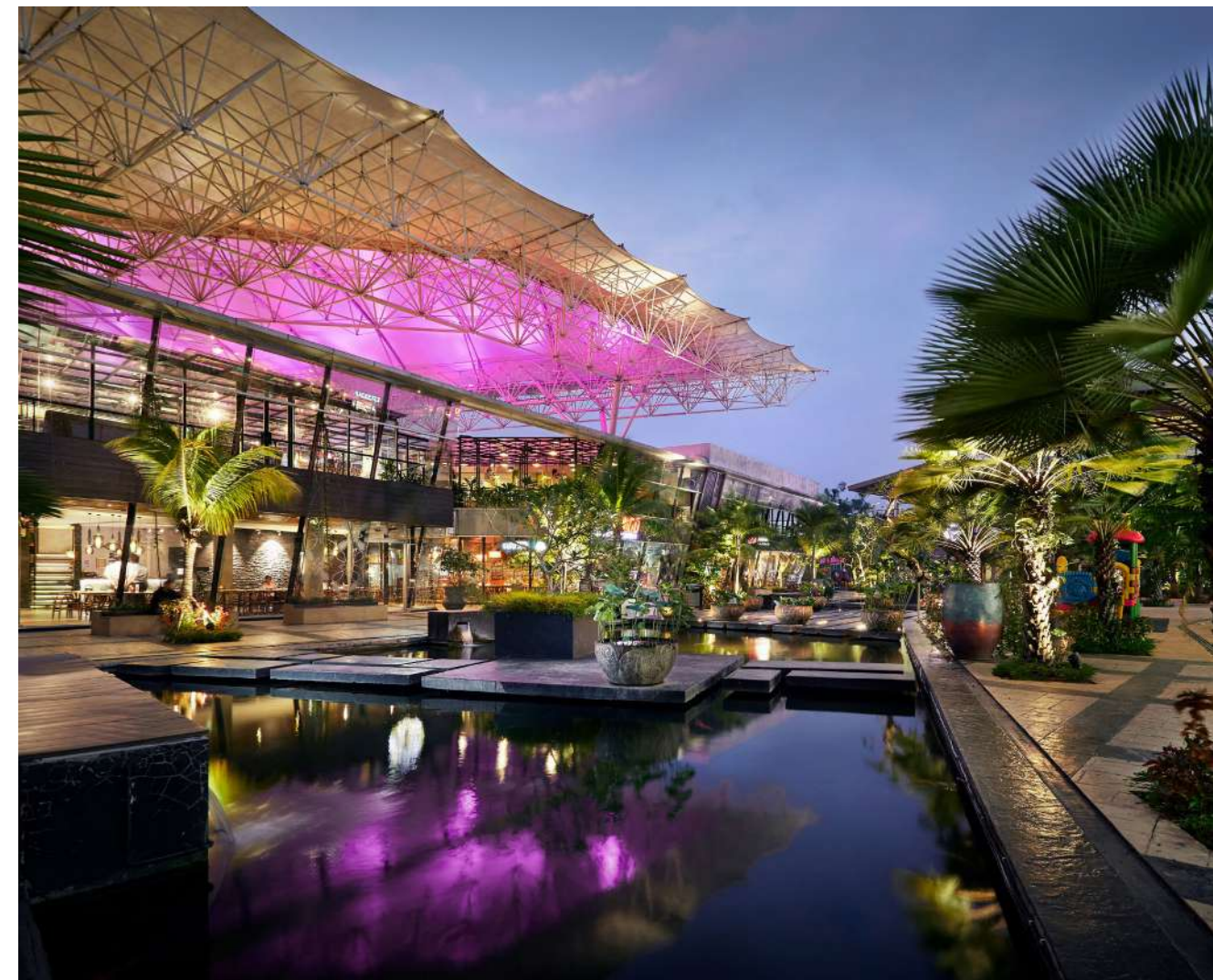


LIFE AT MONASH UNIVERSITY INDONESIA

LIVING IN JAKARTA — BSD CITY



At Monash University, Indonesia, you'll enjoy a safe, modern and globally-connected environment in BSD City, a thriving township that blends education, innovation and lifestyle.

STUDYING IN BSD CITY

BSD City is a modern, master-planned township in Tangerang, just outside Jakarta. It has everything you need within easy reach – cafes, restaurants, shopping malls, supermarkets, co-working spaces, parks and healthcare facilities. The campus is located in Green Office Park, a sustainable business district surrounded by greenery and lifestyle hubs.

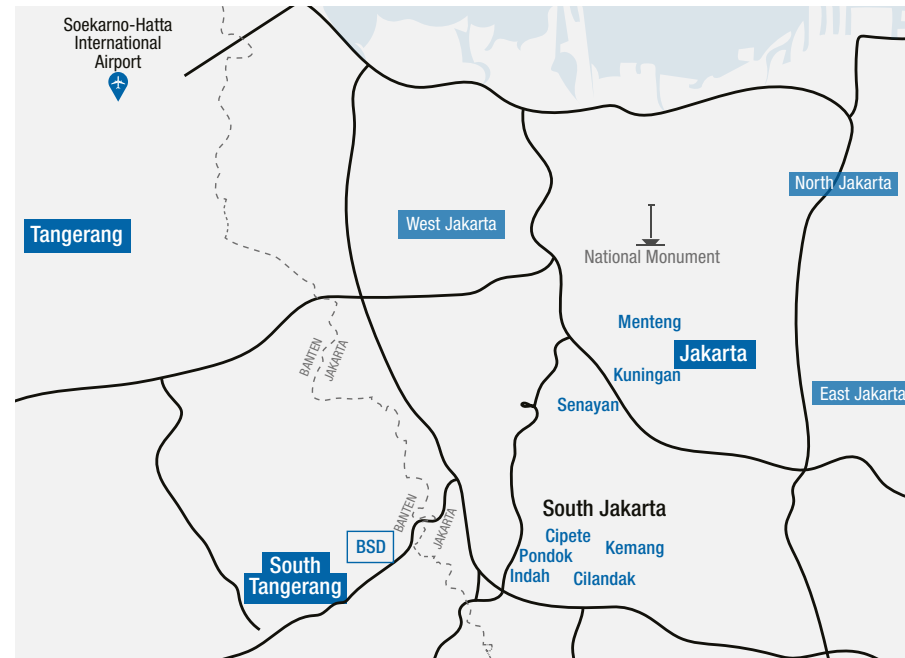
Jakarta's vibrant city centre is just 45 minutes away, where you'll find landmarks such as the National Monument (Monas), Kota Tua (Old Town), museums and regular cultural festivals. For weekend getaways, Banten's beaches and Bogor's cool mountain climate are just a short trip away.

COST OF LIVING (ESTIMATED IN IDR)

Before starting your studies, it's useful to plan a budget. Here are some indicative monthly expenses in BSD City/Jakarta:

- **Accommodation:** IDR 4,000,000 to 9,000,000 (boarding houses, serviced apartments, shared housing)
- **Phone and internet:** IDR 200,000 to 500,000
- **Groceries:** IDR 1,000,000 to 2,500,000
- **Eating out:** IDR 25,000 to 80,000 per meal (local warung to mid-range cafes)
- **Entertainment:** From IDR 50,000 per event (movies, concerts, exhibitions)
- **Transport (online taxis, buses, trains):** IDR 500,000 to 1,500,000.

Overall, BSD City offers an affordable lifestyle compared to other major global study destinations.



TRAVEL OPTIONS

Our campus in BSD City is well-connected:

- Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK) – 45 minutes by car
- Commuter Line (KRL) – from Sudirman/Tanah Abang to Cisauk Station, connected directly to intermoda terminal by skybridge
- BSD shuttle and buses – regular services connect BSD with Jakarta city centre and nearby areas
- Online transport (Grab, Gojek, Maxim) – affordable and widely available for daily commuting.

WITHIN BSD CITY

Free shuttle services and eco-friendly buses operate between key BSD locations: AEON Mall, ICE Convention Centre, The Breeze lifestyle centre, BSD Junction and nearby residential complexes. Students can also walk or cycle safely on pedestrian-friendly pathways around Green Office Park.

MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

When you apply to a Monash undergraduate course, you must satisfy all of the following requirements:

1 MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS: You must be at least 17 years of age to enrol in an undergraduate course. Some exemptions may apply. Visit [go.monash.edu/age-requirements](#).

2 ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All undergraduate courses require applicants to have successfully completed the equivalent of a Year 12 high school education and achieved the required academic entry score. This guide only provide the basic course entry requirements – full details are available on our website.

3 ENGLISH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All undergraduate courses require applicants to satisfy English entry requirements where different entry levels apply. The measure of English must be completed within three years prior to the Monash course commencement date (other guidelines may apply). **English entry requirements can be met in one of the following ways:**

Language of instruction: You can meet English entry requirements if you have completed half a year of full time study (equivalent to 24 Monash credit points) at Australian VET Diploma (AQF level 5) or higher (or equivalent) at an institution where English is the language of instruction, communication and assessment for all aspects of study for the whole of the educational institution.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

WHEN SHOULD YOU APPLY FOR STUDY?

Apply as early as possible, as some courses may close a few months or a year before the course start date. This allows time for your application to be processed and can help to secure a place if your preferred course has limited places. Applying early also gives you time to get your student visa, which can take up to six months for some nationalities and countries.

WHEN SHOULD YOU APPLY FOR A STUDENT VISA?

Students are encouraged to begin the application and visa process as early as possible, approximately two months before, to allow sufficient processing time before the commencement of studies.

DEFER YOUR STUDY

Monash generally allows study deferment for up to 12 months, or longer in exceptional circumstances. If you decide to delay your course commencement, send your deferral request to mi.admissions@monash.edu or through your Monash education agent, if applicable.
