- (a) at all times during the period of twelve months prior to the date of commencement of their term of office, either:
 - (i) have been enrolled at an Australian campus of the University at no less than 0.5 equivalent full-time student load (EFTSL); or
 - (ii) been granted an intermission from a course of study at an Australian campus of the University pursuant to regulation 70 of the *Monash University (Council) Regulations*; or
 - (iii) a combination of (i) and (ii); and
- (b) be either a resident of Australia or living in Australia under a student visa; and
- (c) if that person is also an employee of the university, have a fractional appointment not exceeding 0.5 full-time equivalent.
