

# MONASH SPORT 3 ON 3 BASKETBALL RULES SUMMARY

Court and ball	A regular 3x3 court playing surface is 15m (width) x 11m (length). In this competition a traditional size 7 basketball will be used.
Team roster	Up to 5 players – 3 on court and 2 substitutes. Teams must start with 3 players on court.
Referees	1
Scorers	1 from each team
Timeouts	1 time out per half per team of 1 minute is permitted. Cannot be taken in the final 2 mins of either half.
Initial possession	Coin toss
Scoring	1 point and 2 points from behind the arc.
Game duration	2 x 15-minute halves. Clock does not stop.
Overtime	First team to score 2 points wins the game.
Shot clock	15 seconds as determined by the referee; the referee will count down the final 5 seconds.
Free throw(s) following a shooting foul	1 free throw 2 free throws, if foul committed behind the arc
Foul limit per team	6 team fouls
Penalty for team fouls 7, 8 and 9	2 free throws
Penalty for team fouls 10 and more	2 free throws + ball possession
Possession following a successful goal	Defence possession from the changeover zone at the top of the arc.
Possession following a dead ball	Changeover zone at the top of the arc.
Possession following a defensive rebound or steal	Ball to be dribbled/passed behind the changeover zone at the top of the arc.
Possession following a jump ball situation	Defence possession
Substitutions	In dead ball situations, prior to the check ball, the substitute can enter the game after his teammate steps off the court and establishes a physical contact with him behind the end line opposite the basket. Substitutions require no action from the referees or table officials
